

Osage County Commission Meeting Minutes

October 3rd, 2019

Meeting called to order by Presiding Commissioner Darryl Griffin at 08:33 AM

Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

-District 2 Commissioner Larry Kliethermes moves to approve the Agenda and Meeting Minutes with changes, seconded by District 1 Commissioner John Glavin, followed by 3 ayes in a roll call vote.

Old Business:

New Business:

- Commissioner Griffin stated that next week the City of Linn will be black topping the roads around the county building. Chief Deputy Hamilton stated the County Clerk's office was informed that parking would be best in the square.
- Commissioner Griffin asked Chief Deputy Hamilton what the bill was for from 4Imprint. Hamilton stated it was for the poll workers as a thank you. Griffin asked "well don't they get paid?" Hamilton stated that the poll workers do get paid but we wanted to do something nice for them and the funds are coming from the County Clerk's Election Services fund. Commissioner Glavin spoke up and stated that it was a token of appreciation.
- County Clerk Kammerich asked if the commission wanted to go over the budget or if there were any questions. Commission decided that they wanted to look over everything and address it at a later time.

Road and Bridge:

- Closure of the Bridge on CR 611 is in affect as of yesterday morning at 9:30AM. Kempker stated that it's not something they like to do but it's something that they can't help.
- Kempker stated he wanted to speak openly about some issues he sees. Recently CR 603 was graded and it looked great, but people are driving to road to fast and sliding around corners. The operators are doing the best they can but they can only do what they can do. Commissioner Griffin stated that people need to be considerate of other people.
- Commissioner Kliethermes stated he had a half hour conversation with Norman Bailey who stated we promised to do a chip and seal to his road. Kliethermes said he informed Bailey that we gave his road just as much attention as other roads. Bailey believes the road needs to be resurfaced and told Kliethermes he would keep on him until he got what he wanted.
- Bridge on CR 611 is to have an engineer come out to look and discuss with commission cost and repairs.
- Deputy Valerie Prater present commission and Foreman Kempker with an email she had received from a concerned citizen regarding CR 506, CR 507 and CR 508. Foreman Kempker is to contact citizen.

Public Comments:

- County Clerk Nicci Kammerich stated that as an appreciation gift for the poll workers the County Clerk's office has order some tote bags, water bottles and pens to thank our poll workers for the hard work they do for Election Days.
- County Clerk Kammerich stated that her staff has been working very hard in getting the poll worker training set up. Kammerich invited commission to attend the poll worker training so they can see what it pertains to.
- Poll workers are required by statute to have training each year for the following election year.
- Commissioner Griffin stated he appreciates the work that has been done by the County Clerk and her staff as well as the poll workers.
- Chief Deputy Hamilton made public comment that all county offices will be closed October 14th, 2019 due to Columbus Day also there will be no Commission Meeting on November 5th, 2019 due to the Special Election.
