-Commissioner Larry Kliethermes said CR 515 needs the ditch cut out. He received a call asked when they send the grader out to grade it down the whole county road. CR 514 the loops on top, there was a telephone wire cut out, and an AT&T box was put in.

-Kempker said John from R&B will start with CR 508 and make it up to those roads.


