December 03, 2019

Meeting called to order by Presiding Commissioner Darryl Griffin at 8:30 AM

New Business:

-Commission received a check from the City of Linn for the Missouri S&T reimbursement. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to deposit the check into BG89, seconded by Commissioner Glavin, followed by all three ayes in a roll call vote.
-Commission discussed a timesheet from the Sheriff's office. The employee did not submit it on time. Either we pay it not or have him wait for 2 months to get paid. Prater spoke up and said the Sheriff's office will be getting a deposit December 15, 2019. Commissioner John Glavin made the motion, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes, followed by all three ayes in a roll call vote.
-Commission received a letter from Osage County Special Services. Diane Brandt was a board member and is resigning, and Katherine Best would like to be appointed to the board. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to appoint Best, Commissioner John Glavin seconded the motion, followed by all three ayes in a roll call vote.
-Discussed the McClure LPA On-Call, Prater from the Clerk's office is going to send an email back to them stating we never received any study about Hwy 50.
-Commissioner Darryl Griffin said Ron thanks for knocking down those pins on the parking spots from last week. Kempker replied I didn't get to them, because I didn't have time. Commissioner Griffin, said I know I did it.

Road and Bridge:

-Foreman's Road Report for November 26th – December 3rd, 2019.
-Foreman Ron Kempker said it was a short week last week, but a busy week with mother nature causing all the wind.
-Kempker said he got a request for a pipe for CR 319. For the 31-foot pipe is \$7,700.00. The 32-foot pipe is \$9,160.00 and the 30-foot is \$9,700.00. We will have to pay them to cut them in half. That is the price for the whole cost shipped to our yard. Commissioner John Galvin said to call DeLong's pipe company and get a price from them.
-Kempker said the Repair on CR 275 has started working on the box culvert today.
-Commissioner John Glavin said the pipe on CR 274A past the bridge looks good. Just need to add something to the end. Kempker said if people would stop cutting the corner so sharp it would be in better shape. Road and Bridge is going to put a sign up to block people from doing that.
-Commission, Kempker, and County Clerk discussed the credit card for the phone bill. Kempker needs to set it up as an automatic pay instead of monthly you pay it. Just print a receipt out and submit it to the Clerk's office.
-Commissioner Darryl Griffin said to keep an eye out on CR 303 with all the trucks running up and down his road. Kempker said they are making progress and seems to be doing a good job.
