**Health Department:**

-Kim Sallin said we have 145 active cases, 988 total cases. DHSS put out new guidance on cases for us to work only ones received in the last 6 days which includes kids under the age of 18. The state is working the elderly cases. We exceed the extreme risk category for the county being at 595 cases per 100,000 in the last 7 days. The CDC says if a case is more than 14 days old, they don't want us to work the case because anyone they would have been in contact with would be getting off quarantine. We won't be sending to the state any longer, only working the last 6 days cases. Had 10 cases with kids 15 and under. Have several cases in daycares. Commissioner Griffin said have you heard anything about the vaccination? Sallin said until we get notification, I don't put a lot of faith into it. It will take a long time to get to the general public. The schools are doing rapid testing.

**911:**

-Ron Hoffman said for the paid cares act stuff I thought this went to the clerk's office and they are telling me to give it to you. It's the stuff paid for; do you want the receipts. Commissioner Griffin said did you get them down to Kelly? Hoffman said Kelly has everything.

**New Business:**

-Commissioner Griffin said we need to discuss with downstairs before signing the doorbell closure. We have the windows, masks and sanitizer and now we are going to make people wait outside. Commissioner Kliethermes said we need to put a bigger sign up saying please wear a mask.
