Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

-Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion for approval of today's agenda and the meeting minutes for January 28th, 2021. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to approve the agenda and the minutes. Commissioner Trenshaw seconded the motion. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Griffin, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Kliethermes all stated aye. -Commissioners received letter from State of MO Treasurer's office and per the new timeline from the Governor's office, any unspent funds will now need to be returned to the state by September 1, 2021.

-Commissioner Kliethermes spoke with Amanda Grellner on January 28th, 2021, alluding 2 weeks to respond to remove Pentecostal bridge on CR611 out of the creek.

Meetings:

Road and Bridge:

-One operator is currently out but there is another employee cross training.
-Road report for January 26th, 2021-February 1, 2021 was handed out.

-Oil Furnace at shop is getting worked on today.
-Part time position open, CDL required.

Building and Grounds:

-Need to get handicap signs ordered. We need 4 signs for handicap only. We need 8 signs for county employee parking only. We need 2 signs for fire lane. Commissioners are to discuss exact wording for the signs needed. Commissioner Trenshaw made motion to get price quotes on signage. Commissioner Kliethermes second. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. All commissioners said aye. Commissioner Griffin said all opposed, none.

Health Department:

-Kim reported that yesterday we held another vaccine (Moderna) clinic at the community center, taking 5 staff members 12 hours to prep and call about 300 people. All-in-all 228 people were vaccinated. Lots of wonderful feedback from community.
-Vaccines are by appointment ONLY. Please call the health department to be put on a list and they will contact you to schedule the vaccine as it comes available. 573-897-3103
-Commissioners all thanked Kim and her staff for running such a great and smooth-running vaccine clinic.

Sheriff:
