Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

-Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion for approval of today's agenda and the meeting minutes for February 15, 2022. Commissioner Kliethermes made a motion to approve today's agenda and the previous meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Trenshaw. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Bills, Notes and Communication:

-Commissioner Griffin spoke with the Treasurer to possibly get paid twice a month and due to some departments not turning in timesheets on time, it's too much. Neuner told Commissioner Griffin he will not be running again for Treasurer.

-Commissioner Kliethermes said county road 251, there is a culvert that is too narrow to get machinery across. Kliethermes will take a look at the road and see if the county could widen it.

-Commissioner Kliethermes will continue to research which bridges the county wants to look at as a county project.

-Valerie Prater came to the meeting clocked out and as an independent person to let the commissioners know that she is publicly running as Osage County Treasurer and would like their support.

-Round table discussion went well.

Assessor:

-Tina Kammerich had a vehicle maintenance and it needs about \$1,800 in repairs. Kammerich also wonders if a second vehicle is even needed at this time. Kammerich is to research if she can sell the vehicle as is or if we have to keep it for an amount of time before selling.

Sheriff:

-Sheriff Bonham came to the commissioner along with Nicci Kammerich as support and would like to switch pay cycles for his deputies to match the rest of the county. They are currently on a 28 day pay cycle. Bonham asks to back up the end of the payroll cycle to match the rest of the county time reporting. Tim Neuner was consulted by Nicci Kammerich prior to the meeting in which he agreed to this. This would only add one extra pay period this year. Bonham needs permission from the commissioners. Commissioner Griffin asked if there has been previously an issue turning in time sheets. Bonham denies knowledge of issues since we went to the current t-sheets. Commissioner Griffin asked for a motion to add one extra pay period for April and move the second pay to September for Sheriff's Office only. Motion made by Commissioner Trenshaw, seconded by Commissioner Kliethermes. Commissioner Griffin asked all in favor say aye. Commissioner Kliethermes, Commissioner Trenshaw and Commissioner Griffin all stated aye. All opposed, none.
