**3. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING DIGITAL MESSAGING RFP RESPONSES**

Ms. McArthur presented her digital messaging proposal to city council.  
Mayor Pro Tem Wood asked Ms. McArthur about the CrowdRiff agreement that is coming up later in the meeting. Ms. McArthur said if the city could afford it, it would be helpful, but she could make do without if necessary. Councilor Funk asked what the most important thing would be that is currently out of the proposed budget, and Ms. McArthur said that boosting posts would be the first thing she would add to the budget if she could.

Mr. Van Meter presented his proposal to the city, including his past accomplishments working on the website with OTO. Mr. Van Meter is familiar with CrowdRiff and has worked with it with the OTO, but feels it is unnecessary in this case.

Mayor Pro Tem Wood asked to clarify if he was chosen, the city could drop the CrowdRiff agreement. Mr. Van Meter affirmed. Councilor Funk asked Mr. Van Meter what he would like to do most that is not in the budget, and Mr. Van Meter said there was nothing. Councilor Boyd asked why Mr. Van Meter rescinded his proposal and then resubmitted it, and Mr. Van Meter said he was not fond of politics and felt he had been treated unfairly on Monday, but citizens wanted him to re-enter the RFP process for the good of the community.

Jason Perkins thanked the council for their speedy response to this issue.

Tamara Gulde said that both applicants are talented, but felt that Ms. McArthur and her team would be the superior choice with a deeper marketing background and multiple people working.

Mayor Pro Tem wood made a motion to select Mr. Van Meter for the RFP. Councilor Lindsey seconded the motion. Councilor Boyd stated for the record that his vote against this motion wouldn't be against Mr. Van Meter, but a vote for Ms. McArthur.
