

NOTICE TO PEAINE TOWNSHIP VOTERS

MAY 5th, 2020 SPECIAL ELECTION and COVID-19

There will be a May election for Peaine Township voters. There is one proposal on the May ballot. You can view the ballot at the following link: <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/>

Please be aware that all voters are strongly encouraged to vote via absentee ballot as the traditional physical polling place will not be in place in the same form as it usually is on May 5th due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. All voters will be receiving an absentee ballot application mailed directly from the Michigan Bureau of Elections. It should include a postage paid envelope to return the completed application to me. You may also email the completed application or a picture of the completed application to me at peainetownshipclerk@yahoo.com. All absentee ballots that are sent out will also include postage for the ballot return envelope.

Please be aware that my office will not be open for traditional office hours, but by appointment only outside of office hours required for election purposes (Saturday May 2nd 9am-5pm for example). Residents who want to register to vote in the May 5th election are strongly encouraged to do so by April 20. They can register online at mvic.sos.state.mi.us/registervoter or by mail using the form available

at michigan.gov/documents/MIVoterRegistration_97046_7.pdf.

Those who miss the deadline are still able to register to vote and can do so at my office, but should call ahead or email first. Clerks will also be able to accept applications and proof of residency by mail, email or fax.
