SEC. 6.31. DANCES

Subd. 1. Definitions. As used in this section, the following words and terms shall have the following meanings:

- A. DANCE.** Any dance or live music where the general public may participate, whether or not a charge for admission for dancing is made.
- B. DANCING PLACE.** Any room or space or other area, outside or on City property, which is open to the general for the purpose of participating in public dancing or listening to live music.

Subd. 2. PERMIT REQUIRED. It is unlawful for any person to operate a public dance, or hold a public dance, including live music, without a license therefor from the City. Indoor dances on private property do not require a permit. All indoor dances must meet fire code capacity as set by the State Fire Marshal.

- A. EXEMPTIONS:** Provided, this section shall not apply to the following; Public School Systems

Subd. 3. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT.

- A. The application shall set forth the name and address of the applicant, who shall be the person responsible for conducting the dance and any business, committee or organization sponsoring the dance, the place where the dance is to be held, the date of the dance and the time of the dance.
- B. The application shall be submitted to the City Clerk at least 20 days before the date of the proposed dance or adequate time to be reviewed by the City Council. The Council shall act upon all dance permit applications at a regular or special meeting.
- C. Proof of insurance required shall be submitted with the application and no permit shall be issued until proof of insurance has been received. Permits held on City property are required to list the City as a named insured and provide a provision to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City and any of its employees from any claims arising from the event.
- D. A request for any use of city property shall be included with the permit application, and no permit shall be issued until the fees for the use of the city building or other city property have also been paid, or Council declares the fee waived.
- E. The applicant shall be responsible for any expense associated with providing security for the event. Security is required for any event where alcohol will be served and must be present during the duration of the event.
- F. When a permit is issued, the holder of the permit shall post the permit in a prominent location on the premises on which the dance is to be held during the time the dance is occurring. The applicant shall always be present while the dance is occurring.
- G. No license shall be issued to any applicant under the age of eighteen (18) years.
- H. The applicant is required to obtain a liquor license where alcohol will be served without first obtaining a license from both the State of Minnesota and the City.

Subd. 4. DANCE REGULATIONS.

A. CERTAIN BEHAVIOR PROHIBITED.

No person present at any dance shall engage in any disorderly conduct, as defined by M.S. §609.72, as it may be amended from time to time, and any disorderly person shall be immediately removed from the dance place. Should a substantial number of persons at the dance engage in disorderly conduct, the applicant shall terminate the dance and remove all persons from the dancing place.

B. MINORS PROHIBITED.

No person under the age of eighteen (18) shall be allowed to be present by permit holder or any peace officer at a dance where alcohol is sold or consumed, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

C. HOURS.

No dance shall occur between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M.

D. PENALTY.

Any permit holder violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and their dance permit is suspended immediately.
