General Fund:	Basic monthly expenditures and revenue. Major expenditure last month		
	for new maintenance truck, much of which will be reimbursed. Note:		
	\$50,000.00 of this is reserved as match for the Campground		
	Improvements project - Recreation Passport (RP) local development		
	grant in the amount of \$150,000.00.		
Street & Road:	Basic monthly expenditures. All revenue for this fund comes from millage		
	levied annually in December and these tax dollars are coming in. Expect		
	expenditure from this fund for improvements to campground access		
	road.		
Municipal Dock:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. Summer expenditures over. This		
	fund is very tight.		
Sewer Use:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. All sewer users continue to pay in		
	a timely manner. We had budgeted for an additional \$5,000.00 to be		
	transferred from this fund to the sewer capital improvement fund, but		
	because of necessary expenditures this year, the \$5,000.00 should not be		
	transferred. New sewer rates in effect with first statement of 2020 – rates		
	up \$.50 per Residential Equivalency Unit (REU).		
Sewer Capital	This fund does not receive tax dollars. This fund is set up to save money		
Improvement:	for capital improvement projects related to the sanitary sewer.		
Lighthouse:	This fund is set up to save money for improvements to the Whiskey		
	Point Lighthouse.
