General Fund:	Note: \$50,000.00 of this is reserved as match for the Campground Improvements project - Recreation Passport (RP) local development grant in the amount of \$150,000.00. \$25,000.00 from the Tribal Grant has been moved to the Municipal Dock fund as a match for a Waterways Commission Grant of \$80,900.00 for emergency	
	repair to the marina north fuel dock project, and \$50,000.00 is reserved as a match for a Waterways Commission Grant of \$178,300.00 for emergency electrical improvements at the municipal marina. Basically, \$100,000.00 of GF money has netted \$409,200.00 in grants and donations for township projects.	
Street & Road:	Basic monthly expenditures. All revenue for this fund comes from millage levied annually in December and have been collected. Since last month, this fund received \$13,000.00 as historic payback from the sewer fund.	
Municipal Dock:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. Summer 2020 reservation dollars are coming in, but so have cancellations because of Covid-19. Unsure of what the summer will bring, we will be monitoring closely to adjust expenditures as needed, primarily in regard to staffing.	
Sewer Use:	This fund does not receive tax dollars. All sewer users continue to pay in a timely manner. New sewer rates in effect with rates up \$.50 per Residential Equivalency Unit (REU). Because of economic downturn related to Coronavirus Pandemic, township will waive late fees until September 1, 2020. Since last month, this fund sent \$13,000.00 as historic payback to the street & road fund.	
Sewer Capital	This fund does not receive tax dollars. This fund is set up to save money for	
Improvement:	capital improvement projects related to the sanitary sewer.	
Lighthouse:	This fund is set up to save money for improvements to the Whiskey Point Lighthouse. Expect approximately \$600.00 to be added from 2019 lighthouse tours.	
Other Monthly Notes:	Expect to do a 2020-2021 Budget Amendment in September.
