The Beaver Island Transportation Authority (BITA) is seeking quotes for removing, replacing, and adding additional timber piles, installing new and raising existing pileguard fenders at the Beaver Island Boat Company (BIBCO) ferry dock, Beaver Island, Michigan. The total number of new piles will be six. There is a total of nine pileguard fenders to be installed on piles (BIBCO has nine fenders). Four pileguard fenders need to be raised. The proposer will work around the ferry schedule (so as not to interfere with the arrivals and departures of the ferry) and the job must be completed by August 11, 2017. The required specifications to be met are listed on the attached pdf file entitled "Replacements 2017". A photo of the existing fenders is also attached.

The contractor will be responsible for and include in their proposal:

- Cost of all necessary materials (timbers (six piles) and hardware)
- Necessary installation hardware for nine pileguard fenders (BIBCO has pileguard fenders)
- Mobilization
- Equipment and labor
- Any other necessary costs to complete the job
- Three references, including company name, address, contact person, phone and mailing address.

The project is funded by the Michigan Department of Transportation grants. It is subject to Federal and State guidelines. BITA complies with all Federal and State civil rights, equal opportunity, and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

BITA is a tax exempt agency.

The selected firm will contract with BITA and may be required to have a third party subcontract approved by MDOT. The awarded subcontract serves as the agency's award to the selected firm and is the firm's notice to proceed. If an MDOT-approved subcontract is not required, the agency will issue its own notice to proceed. The agency reserves the right to cancel the contract. The contractor will name the BITA/BIBCO on its insurance policy.

The selected firm shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the agency, its officers, agents, employees, independent contractors, the State of Michigan, MDOT, BIBCO and all officers, agents, employees thereof:

From any and all claims by persons, firms, or corporations for labor, materials, supplies or services provided in connection with any contract awarded, which the offeror shall perform under the terms of this contract; and

From any and all claims for injuries to, or death of, any and all persons, for loss of or damage to property, environmental damage, degradation response and cleanup costs, and attorney fees or other related costs arising out of, under, or by reasons of this RFQ, except claims resulting from the sole negligence or willful acts or omissions of said indemnities, its agents or employees.

The selected firm is not entitled to a time extension or compensation for reasonable delays, inconvenience. The agency reserves the right to cancel the contract.
