2. SHS Epidemic Use of Vaping Devices & Electronic Cigarettes

Mayor Lansford presented a letter to the Council from Streator Township High School administration to adjust the smoking ordinance to prohibit vaping on SHS property. City Attorney Churney relayed that the Illinois law was going to increase the age for purchasing tobacco on July 1, 2019 to age 21. The consensus of the Council was to have the City Attorney prepare an ordinance to be placed on the June agenda.
