SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

1. RESOLUTION 2019-46. AUTHORIZING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PURCHASE OF 803 EAST HICKORY STREET FOR THE CITY OF STREATOR, LASALLE AND LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.
