

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
COUNCIL CHAMBERS - 204 SOUTH BLOOMINGTON STREET

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Lansford called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL Members present: Pro Tem Mayor Tara Bedei, Ed Brozak, Brian Crouch and Joe Scarbeary.

Members absent: Mayor Jimmie Lansford.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA There were no changes to the agenda.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Greg Spradling – He is concerned about moving the Schultz Monument to the old Keen Station property. He doesn't think they need a main location. He suggested they move to Spring Lake Road or one of the cemeteries. He thinks the Keen property would be a great place to relocate the Historical Society Museum. He would also like to see a no passing zone extended to Columbus Road.

Christine Stapleton – There is a problem with the speed limit in their alley at 110 E. Bronson Street. It is very hazardous. She would also like a shrub at 1121 N. Bloomington Street to be removed.

NEW BUSINESS

1. RESOLUTION 2019-48. AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF BID TO SANDRY FIRE SUPPLY TO PURCHASE NEW VEHICLE EXTRICATION EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, STREATOR, ILLINOIS.

Gary Bird, Fire Department Chief, presented this item to the Council reporting that three bids were submitted to purchase the extrication emergency equipment for the Fire Department. Sandry Fire Supply came in under budget for the bid.

Pro Tem Bedei requested a motion and second to approve and award the bid to Sandry Fire Supply to purchase new vehicle extraction emergency equipment for the Streator Department.

MOTION: Crouch made a motion to approve the bid to Sandry Fire Supply; seconded by Brozak.

2. MOTION TO RECEIVE AND PLACE ON FILE THE PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION 2019-12 RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND GRANTING OF A “FACADE GRANT” TO DANIEL CRAMPTON, OWNER, 125 SOUTH PARK STREET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 AND PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION 2019-13 RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND GRANTING OF A “FACADE GRANT” TO DANIEL CRAMPTON, OWNER, 127 SOUTH PARK STREET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.

Dave Plyman, City Manager, presented this item to the agenda. The Plan Commission is approving façade grants for 125 and 127 South Bloomington Street. There are two projects that have been awarded that will not begin until next year, so there are funds. Pro Tem Mayor

Bedei requested a motion to place on file the Plan Commission's recommendations 2019-12 and 2019-13.

MOTION: Brozak made a motion to place Plan Commission's recommendations on file; seconded by Crouch.

3. RESOLUTION 2019-49. APPROVING AND AWARDED A "FACADE GRANT" IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 TO DANIEL CRAMPTON, OWNER, 125 SOUTH PARK STREET.

Pro Tem Mayor Bedei requested a motion and second to approve and award a "Facade Grant" in the amount of \$15,000 to Daniel Crampton, owner, 125 South Park Street.

MOTION: Scarbeary made a motion to approve and award the "Facade Grant" to property owner, Daniel Crampton, 125 South Park Street, in the amount of \$15,000; seconded by Crouch.

4. RESOLUTION 2019-50. APPROVING AND AWARDED A "FACADE GRANT" IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 TO DANIEL CRAMPTON, OWNER, 127 SOUTH PARK STREET.

Pro Tem Mayor Bedei requested a motion and second to approve and award a "Facade Grant" in the amount of \$15,000 to Daniel Crampton, owner, 127 South Park Street.

MOTION: Scarbeary made a motion to approve and award the "Facade Grant" to property owner, Daniel Crampton, 127 South Park Street, in the amount of \$15,000; seconded by Crouch.

5. RESOLUTION 2019-51. AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE LEVY OF AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF .02 PERCENT ON REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF STREATOR PURSUANT TO 75 ILCS 5/3-1 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020.

Plyman reported this item is presented to the Council annually for the levy of an additional .02 percent on real property for the City Library. Pro Tem Mayor Bedei requested a motion and second to authorize and approve the levy of an addition tax of .02 percent on real property within the City of Streator pursuant to 75 ILCS 5/3-1.

MOTION: Scarbeary made a motion to authorize and approve the levy for the Streator Public Library; seconded Brozak.

ROLL: Ayes: Pro Tem Bedei, Brozak, Crouch and Scarbeary.

Absent: Mayor Lansford.

6. MOTION TO RECEIVE AND PLACE ON FILE STREATOR PARKS AND OPEN SPACES BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS:

1) The recommendation requests that the \$40,000 appropriated for FY 2019 to improve Central Park and install playground equipment from Sherman Park be carried over in the budget for FY 2020 so these improvements can be made.

2) The Streator Parks and Open Spaces recommends that a plaque be placed on "The Swing Bridge" at Spring Lake, in memory of Karel Fennick.

Plyman explained this is simply a request to budget additional funds for the 2020 budget. These two recommendations are being placed on file and not funded at this time.

MOTION: Brozak made a motion to place on the file the two recommendations from the Streator Parks and Open Spaces Board for the 2020 budget; seconded by Scarbeary.

ROLL: Ayes: Pro Tem Bedei, Brozak, Crouch and Scarbeary.
Absent: Mayor Lansford.

7. CONSENT AGENDA

Mayor Pro Tem Bedei requested a motion and second to approve items on the Consent Agenda.
