The City of Streator will hold a public hearing on May 29, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., in Streator City Hall, 204 S Bloomington, Streator, IL 61364 to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed Rebuild Illinois Fat-Track Public Infrastructure Grant (RIFTPI) project. Bloomington Street, Streator, IL 61364, 815-672-2517 no later than May 28, 2020. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about May 30, 2020, the City of Streator intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the Rebuild Illinois program. This program is funded by state funds as included in the 2019 Capital Bill. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: asphalt milling and overlaying, brick pavement replacement, and concrete pavement repair of various City streets. The total amount of Rebuild Illinois funds to be requested is \$5,000,000. The City of Streator also proposes to expend \$136,609.82 in non-Rebuild Illinois funds on the project. These non-Rebuild Illinois funds will be derived from the following sources: City sales tax fund.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of May 21, 2020 at the office of the City Clerk between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Interested residents are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to City Engineer, 204 S. Bloomington, Streator, IL 61364 no later than May 29, 2020 in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Streator and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses. RESOLUTION 2020- 51

COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS TO REBUILD ILLINOIS FAST-TRACK PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT (RIFTPD) FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Streator, Counties of LaSalle and Livingston, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois Fast-Track Public Infrastructure grant application, and;

WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Streator, Counties of LaSalle and Livingston to undertake the project to rehabilitate various city streets, and;

WHEREAS, criteria are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds, and;

WHEREAS, the City Streator, Counties of LaSalle and Livingston, Illinois has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with cash on hand, as needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Streator, Counties of LaSalle and Livingston of Illinois does hereby commit funds from the **City Sales Tax Fund** for use in conjunction with a Rebuild Illinois Public Infrastructure Grant, such funds to equal 2.75% of the estimated total project cost of \$5,000,000, or \$136,609.82.
