

STATE OF MICHIGAN REQUIREMENTS

HOMEOWNERS PLUMBING, MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL PERMIT

Homeowner Definition: A homeowner is a person who occupies or will occupy a single family dwelling.

I agree to:


1. Apply for the appropriate permits.
2. Do all the work myself.
3. Pay the required fee.
4. Request for inspection by and approval of the inspector.
5. Make any required corrections.
6. **I understand that under Michigan Law, if I do not demonstrate knowledge and competence in performing this work, the Inspector is required to cancel my permit, and all work will stop immediately.**

The STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT 230 OF 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, PROHIBITS A PERSON FROM CONSPIRING TO CIRCUMVENT THE LICENSING REQUIREMENT OF THIS STATE RELATING TO PERSONS WHO ARE TO PERFORM WORK ON A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING OR A RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE. **VIOLATORS OF SECTION 23a ARE SUBJECTED TO CIVIL FINES.**

ALL WORK SHALL BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MICHIGAN PLUMBING, MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL CODE AND SHALL NOT BE ENCLOSED, COVERED UP, OR PUT INTO OPERATION UNTIL IT HAS BEEN **INSPECTED** AND **APPROVED** BY THE INSPECTOR. I WILL COOPERATE WITH THE INSPECTOR AND ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITY TO ARRANGE FOR NECESSARY INSPECTIONS

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STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE SINGLE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT (EXCERPT)

Act 230 of 1972

125.1523a Civil violation; penalty; enforcement.

Sec. 23a.

(1) In addition to any other penalties or remedies provided by law, a person who is required to be licensed as a residential builder or residential maintenance and alteration contractor, or as a master or journeyman plumber, an electrical contractor or master or journeyman electrician, or a mechanical contractor shall not perform work on a residential building or a residential structure without first obtaining a license. A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil violation, and shall be fined not less than \$100.00 or more than \$500.00.

(2) The prosecuting attorney of the county in which the residential building or residential structure is located or the attorney general may enforce this section.
