

“Live in the Village and Have Property on the Creek? How Do I Clear the Creek if it’s Jammed Up?”

The East Branch of Coon Creek meanders North to South through the western part of the Village. Large downed trees, tree branches, or other refuse that falls or gets thrown into Coon Creek can become “snagged”. These snags prevent the water from flowing freely during rain events and can actually allow water to stagnate becoming a source of mosquitos and unpleasant smells.

Macomb County’s Department of Public Works has advised the Village that if a snag is reported to them, they can come out and assess it for removal.
