

## Marihuana Facilities Application

- Watervliet Charter Township will begin accepting applications on April 1<sup>st</sup> at 9:00 A.M.
- A separate application must be completed for each facility requested:
  - Grower
  - Processor
  - Secure Transporter
  - Provisioning Center
  - Safety Compliance Facility
- Completed application must be accompanied by the initial annual facility fee
- Complete applications will be considered for authorization in consecutive time and date stamp order
- Applicant will receive conditional authorization to operate such marihuana facility providing the facility type authorization is available within the number specified
- Once the limit on the number of authorized is conditionally reached, any additional complete applications will be held in consecutive time/date stamped order for future conditional authorization.
- An applicant waiting for future conditional authorization may withdraw their submission by written notice to the Clerk at any time and receive a refund of the initial annual marihuana fee submitted
- Any application that does not meet the requirement of MMFLA, MMMA, or the Township's ordinance, or any pertinent provision of any State of Michigan or Watervlie Township laws, rules or regulations will be rejected
- Any applicant whose application is denied due to missing, incomplete, erroneous, false, misleading, or negligent information or because of a lack of submission of full fees due, does not have a right to appeal the decision.
- Applicants denied a license based on qualifications may appeal the decision
- Within 30 days from conditional authorization from the Township, the conditionally authorized applicant must submit proof to the Clerk that the applicant has applied for prequalification from the state for a state operating license or has submitted full application for such license
  - If the applicant fails to submit such proof, then such conditional authorization shall be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional authorization shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date stamped order as provided herein
- If a conditionally authorized applicant is denied prequalification for a state operating license or is denied on full application for a state operating license, then such conditional authorization will be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional authorization shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date stamped order as provided herein
- A conditionally authorized applicant shall receive full authorization from the Township to operate the I marihuana facility within the Township upon the applicant providing to the Clerk proof that the applicant has received a state operating license for the marihuana facility in the Township and if the applicant has met all other requirements of this ordinance for operation including but not limited to any zoning approval for the location of the facility within the Township
- If a conditionally authorized applicant fails to obtain full authorization from the Township within one year from the date of conditional authorization, then such conditional authorization shall be canceled by the Clerk and the conditional authorization shall be available to the next applicant in consecutive time and date stamped order as provided herein. The Township Board shall have authority to extend the deadline to obtain full authorization for up to an additional six months on written request of the applicant within thirty days prior to cancellation, upon the reasonable discretion of the Township Board finding good cause for the extension
