(1) This New York State Building Aid estimate considers the fact that certain costs associated with this capital project will not be aided by the New York State Education Department due to restrictions imposed by New York State on what they consider to be qualifying project expensess. A reduction in qualifying expense is principally caused by exceeding the State calculated maximum cost allowance. Each school has its own maximum cost allowance. Exceeding this allowance occurs when the District has used the full allowance to support prior project expenses. The cost allowance recalculates or replenshes its cost capacity five years after every capital project is completed.
