Williamsville is the largest suburban school district in Western New York with nearly 10,000 students, K-12. Located in the Town of Amherst, the district encompasses about 40 square miles and borders the suburban campus of the State University of New York at Buffalo. Portions of the towns of Clarence and Cheektowaga are also served by the school district. Williamsville schools have been educating students since 1893, when it began serving the Village of Williamsville. The district continues to benefit greatly from strong community support and residents who value quality public education for all children.

Williamsville CSD is ranked consistently as one of the top performing school districts in Western New York and in New York State. The district also has been recognized for both administrative efficiency and cost effectiveness, scoring in the top five among all school districts in Western and Upstate New York, according to an annual poll conducted by *Business First*.
