On Friday, June 1, grades K-4 will be participating in our annual Field Day. Once again, we would like to make this day complete with fun-filled activities throughout the day. Students will be rotating to a variety of stations: Field events (i.e. sack race, 50 yard dash), obstacle course, crafts and a performance by Kevin McCarthy.

It is very important that students are dressed appropriately on this day. Students should wear sneakers (please, no open toe sandals/shoes, slip-ons or crocs) when participating on the field as well as having loose clothing. It is also important that students have their own water bottle with their name on it.

In regards to sunscreen, it must be applied before students arrive at school. If a parent would like the sunscreen put on at school, please send in the sunscreen with a parent permission note that will go to Megan O'Neil, our school nurse.

A refreshment station will be provided throughout the day. After students participate on the field, tables will be arranged for them to get a drink and freezer pop (roughly 20 minutes). If your son/daughter is not allowed to have a freezer pop, please provide a different option for them. The Curriculum Diagnostic Team will be organizing and supervising this station.
