Anatomy & Physiology (11,12)

SMART Goal: After two weeks of instruction on the Integumentary System through powerpoint note taking, activity/coloring packet, interactive web activities, and google classroom; the student scores will increase to that 100% of students reach mastery (85%) on the post-test.

Assistive Technology (K,01,02,03,04,05,06,07,08,09,10,11,12)

Annual Goal: The AT team will meet monthly for hands-on technology trainings focused on students' current technology needs.

SMART Goal: The AT team will formally meet monthly to train each other on current educational technology and the AT process as it pertains to specific student needs. The team will complete 8 out of 8 trainings, and review how students can access these new AT tools by the end of the 2018-2019 school year. This information will inform what and how many new AT tools to add to the loan closet.

Chemistry / AP Chemistry (09,10,11,12)

SMART Goal: Students will be able to apply algebraic concepts and skills to solve chemistry based problems. Students average scores on algebra concepts will increase from 72% to 77%. between the pretest and the post test

Choral Music (09,10,11,12)

SMART Goal: 85% of Mixed Chorus students will score 6/8 (75%) by November 9th as measured by an aural assessment.

Environmental Science (11,12)

SMART Goal: Using the note=taking method to increase reading comprehension and add detail to constructed response questions should result in improved quality of work and improved grades on students' Final Projects.

High School Math (11)

SMART Goal: 1) Stress factoring over and over and over as it will be needed in later units. We hope to improve factoring correctly at least 75%.

Latin (09,10,11,12)

SMART Goal: fifty per cent of the students will be able to achieve a perfect score by cycle two.

Annual Goal: Transition from use of traditional OverDrive app to Sora app/interface, including individualized curated collections.

Music Theory (09,10,11,12)

SMART Goal: GOAL: 85% or students will achieve a 51 or higher

Goal: 60% of students will achieve a 61 or higher.

The focus of the instructional time between assessments will be on major/minor scales and keys, the are with the most difficulty for students based on the pre-test results.

Social Studies - Global 9 (09)

SMART Goal: On the unit test we would like 65% of students will reach mastery (80%) on pre-test questions & concepts

Speech-Language Pathology (K,01,02,03,04,05,06,07,08,09,10,11,12)

SMART Goal: Our priority learning need is to increase awareness of and comfort level with specific tools and strategies related to these skills at all levels of student learning (K-12). This will be measured by comparing results of our pre and mini post surveys given to our curriculum extension teachers. Research shows that social pragmatic skills are necessary for successful educational performance, including college and career readiness.

Economics / Government / AP (12)

SMART Goal: Students will achieve mastery (85%) or higher on post-assessment after they have gone through instruction on the units pertaining to Federalism is as well as the three branches of government.

Earth Science (10)

SMART Goal: 85% of Earth Science students will achieve mastery on the Earth Science Lab Practical in June.
