

ORDINANCE NO. 98-003

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE AND PRESENCE OF ALCOHOL BY ANY PERSON, FIRM, CORPORATION, ENTITY, OR COMBINATION OF SAME WHEN LEASING OR RENTING THE OLD RIVER COMMUNITY BUILDING ("THE BUILDING"), SETTING DEPOSIT FEES, REQUIRING WRITTEN RENTAL AGREEMENT, REQUIRING SECURITY PERSONNEL AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF SAID PROVISIONS NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLD RIVER-WINFREE, TEXAS ("THE CITY"):

Section I. That any person, firm, corporation, entity, or a combination of same requesting to hereinafter lease, rent, or use "The Building" shall give notice to "The City" before said request concerning the use or presence of alcoholic beverages during the time requested and the number of persons attending on said date of possession.

Section II. "The City" upon such request shall charge a deposit fee of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) if no alcoholic beverages are to be consumed or present during said period of possession by said person, firm, corporation, entity, or combination of same.


Section III. "The City" upon such request shall charge a deposit fee of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) if alcoholic beverages are to be consumed or present during said period of possession by said person, firm, corporation, entity, or combination of same.

Section IV. "The City" upon such request shall require, if alcohol will be consumed or present at the time of rental or use, that said person, firm, corporation, entity, or combination of same shall provide security in the form of one police officer or a person licensed and trained in security matters per fifty (50) persons attending on the date of rental or use.

Section V. "The City" upon such request shall require said person, firm, corporation, entity, or combination of same to complete and execute a written rental agreement that includes the provisions of this ordinance as well as other terms and conditions as set forth by "The City" concerning the use and/or rental of "The Building".

Section VI. Any person, firm, corporation, entity, or combination of same which violates said ordinance provisions above shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall be fined an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
