2. Can my child play up an age division?

The Woodhaven Parks and Recreation Department strongly encourage players to participate at their correct age division which is set by National Associations. However, exceptions will be made upon meeting the following criteria:

- If a parent is requesting their child be placed in an older age division, they are required to submit a letter to the Recreation Director
- No child may play down a division.

3. What equipment does the Recreation Department provide for my child?

- Jersey with number
- Hat (baseball) / visor (softball)
- Baseball/softball bats for each team.
- Batting helmets are provided, however players are encouraged to purchase their own.
- Pants and/or shorts will not be provided.
