

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF EDMONDS,
WASHINGTON AND TOWN OF WOODWAY, WASHINGTON
FOR POLICE SERVICES**

THIS AMENDMENT No. 1 ("Amendment") is made and entered into as of the date set forth below between the City of Edmonds, a Washington municipal corporation ("Edmonds"), and the Town of Woodway, a Washington municipal corporation ("Woodway") (collectively "the Parties").

RECITALS

A. The Parties entered into an interlocal agreement dated December 19, 2014 ("the Agreement"), under which the City of Edmonds agreed to provide certain police services to the Town of Woodway in exchange for payment of a specified monthly sum.

B. Section I of the Agreement provides that the term of the Agreement will be from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.

C. While the Parties have been in negotiations for a successor interlocal agreement to the Agreement, it has become clear that a successor agreement cannot be reached by December 31, 2017, the end of the Agreement term.

D. The Parties agree to a one-month extension of the Agreement, with all of the terms of the Agreement remaining in place through January 2018, to allow time for the Parties to reach an agreement on a new interlocal agreement.

E. The Parties therefore desire to amend the Agreement to clarify this change to its terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits herein contained, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The first sentence of Section I of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

THIS AGREEMENT for Police Services ("Agreement") shall have a three (3) year term commencing on January 1, 2015 and expiring on January 31, 2018.

2. All other terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this Amendment. If a conflict arises between the terms of this Amendment and the Agreement, the terms of this Amendment shall control.
