Figure 1. New Hospitalizations of Butler County Residents by Admission Date, 2020-21\*

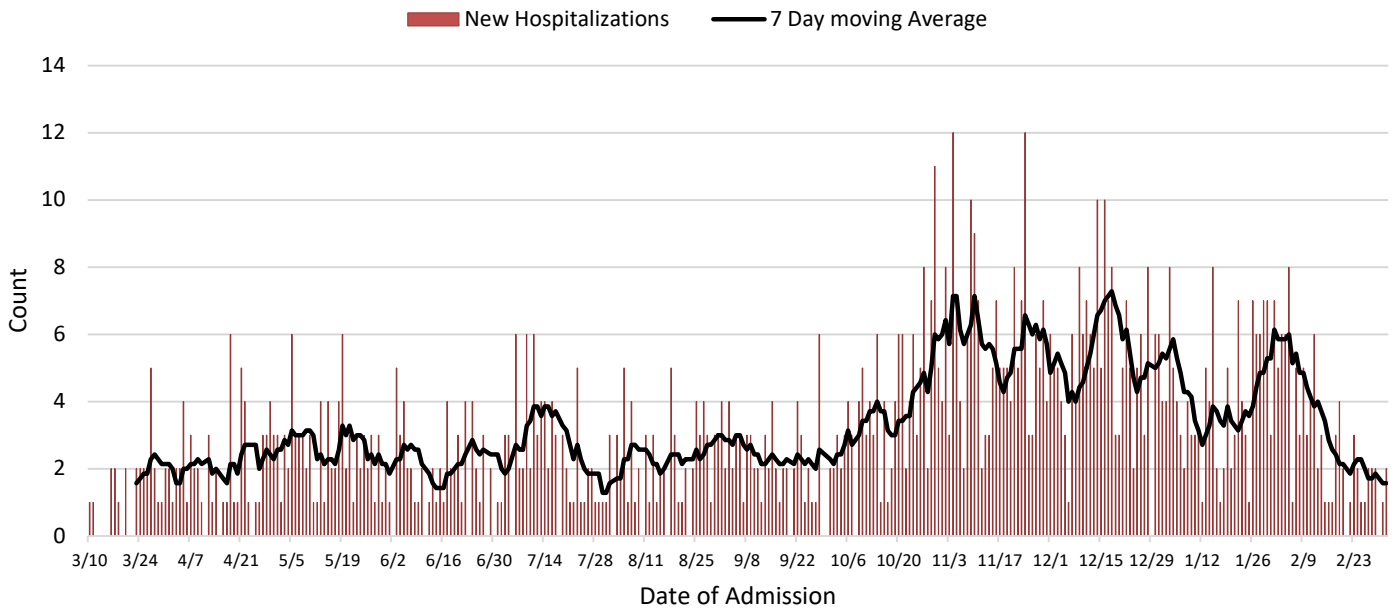
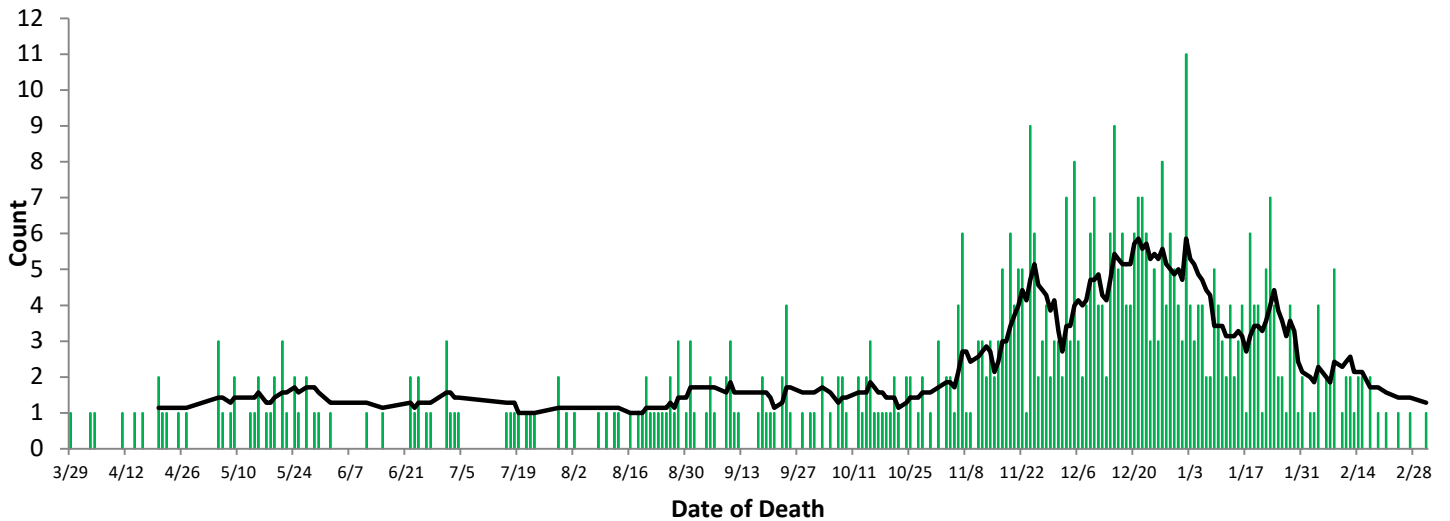


Figure 2. Confirmed COVID-19 Deaths by date of death, 2020-21\*\*

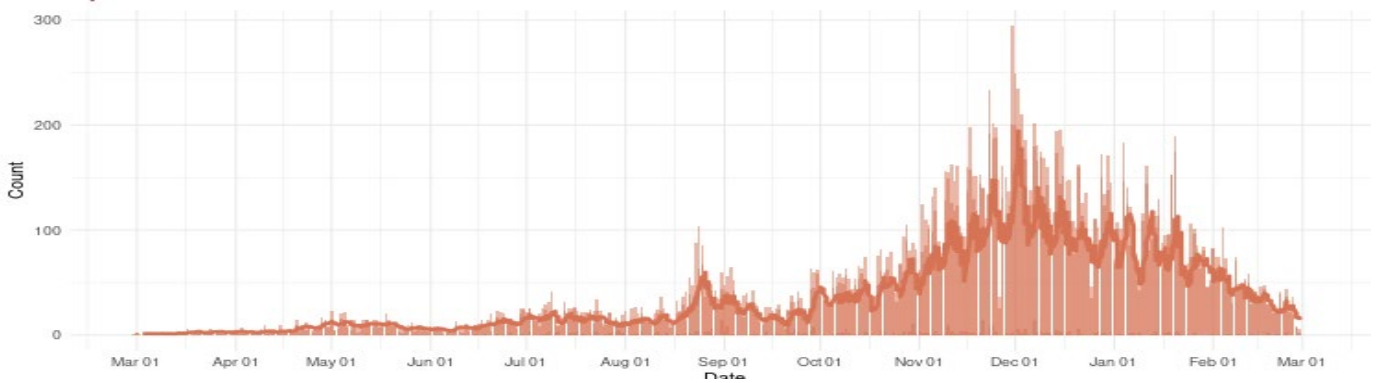

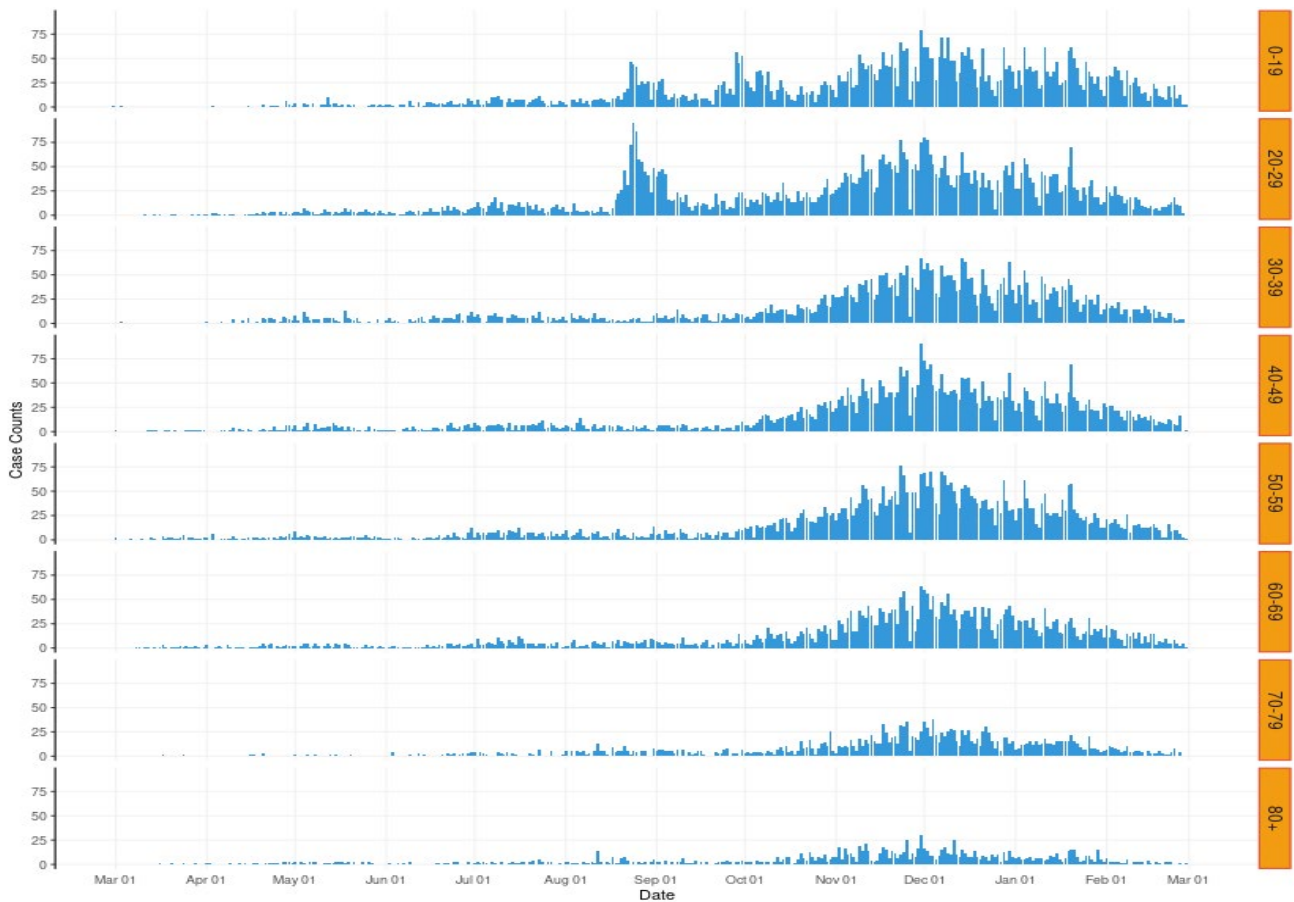
