Planning an Eclipse Event

If you are planning an event, please call our Environmental Health Department at (513) 863-1770 to speak with someone regarding selling food or setting up a temporary campground.

Temporary Food Vendors

- If you plan to sell food during the eclipse, a food license is required in Ohio.

- Fee is \$55.00 USD per event.

Mobile Food Vendors

- If you plan to operate for any events during the April 2024 solar eclipse, you must apply for a mobile food license for the 2024-2025 licensing year prior to the event.
