Job Title:	Plumbing Inspector
Responsible to:	Chief Plumbing Inspector
Positions Supervised:	None
Work Hours:	Full Time (35 hours), usual hours 8-4, M-F, Evenings/weekends may be required.
Pay Range:	\$21.00 - \$23.00 per hour
Grant-Funded:	No

Essential Functions: Conducts plumbing inspections to ensure conformity to all state and local laws and regulations. This includes underground, structural, and final inspections as well as medical gas inspections under the supervision of the Chief Plumbing Inspector. Consults with plumbing contractors, homeowners and hospitals regarding new installations and repairs of existing installations – this includes plan review.

Minimum Qualifications:

- At least seven (7) years of experience as a plumber
- Knowledge of local and Ohio state laws and regulations governing plumbing installations and drainage is required
- Ability to read engineering drawings as related to proper plumbing installation
- Experienced in working with the public and with contractors

Preferred Qualifications:

- Certification in Plumbing Installation Inspection, Testing, Plans Examination and Backflow, or ability to pass examinations within 6 months of hire
- Medical Gas Certification, or has ability to pass test within 1 year of hire
- Basic computer skills (Word, Excel)

Position Specific Responsibilities:

- Inspects plumbing installations and medical gas to ensure code compliance
- Reviews plans of proposed plumbing installations
- Consults with local plumbing contractors on specific job related problems

- Attends state and local meetings, conferences and workshops as approved
- Records inspections in a timely manner
- Works well with other agencies, contractors, and co-workers

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Ability to coordinate numerous demands simultaneously to successful completion
- Basic computer skills including Microsoft Office
- Excellent writing, communication, interpersonal, and public relations skills
- Ability to establish effective working relationships with persons of varied backgrounds
- Ability to be self-motivated to plan, organize and complete work accurately and on time with little direct supervision
- Follows ethical principle of public health practice
- Ability to perform under pressure

Other:

- Serves a probationary period of 120 days
- Must be able to respond to public health emergencies or exercises 24/7, except while on scheduled vacation or other leave
- May be required to play an active leadership role in the event of a public health emergency, which may include changes in responsibilities and working hours
- Evening and weekend work may be required during public health events, investigations or emergencies
- Other duties as assigned
- Position may be subject to background check
- Valid OHIO Driver’s license in good standing, and insurable by the Board of Health’s Policy
- Complete required FEMA classes within 12 months of hire
