**Please Read This Important Information About Vaccines for Children!**

The State of Ohio has new guidelines for paying for children's vaccines.

**WHAT THIS NEW GUIDELINE MEANS TO YOU:**

<b>Insurance Type (or no insurance)</b>	<b>How this will affect your family</b>
If your child has <u>MEDICAID OR A MEDICAID MANAGED CARE PLAN</u> (Caresource, Buckeye, United Health Care Community, Molina, or Paramount)	Your child can continue to receive vaccines at <b>NO CHARGE</b> if you bring in a current insurance card.
If your child has <u>NO INSURANCE</u> , or your <u>insurance does not pay for shots</u>	You will be asked to pay \$10 per shot, with a maximum of \$40 per child, per day. Cash only, no checks, no charges. Children qualifying to receive VFC vaccine will <b>NOT</b> be turned away due to inability to pay.
If your child has <u>PRIVATE/COMMERCIAL INSURANCE</u>	<u>We are no longer able to offer you the state cost for vaccines.</u> You will be charged a fee based on our cost to purchase vaccines from private vendors. Cash only, no checks, no charges. <b>Please call to check for vaccine availability, cost, and to determine if your insurance will cover the cost of receiving vaccines in our clinic.</b> <b>**Please bring medical insurance card.**</b>
