



2020 City of Acworth Logan Farm Pumpkin Patch

WHO:

All local families, non-profits, churches, organizations, and businesses are invited to participate in our first-ever Logan Farm Pumpkin Patch art installation.

WHAT:

Help us celebrate the fall season by decorating your very own wooden pumpkin to be displayed at Logan Farm Park. We supply the pumpkin; you supply the creativity! Use paint, collage, mosaic, or more to create a unique masterpiece to represent your family, business, or organization. Pumpkins will be approximately 2' x 2' and hanged on fencing through a hole in the stem with zip ties. Only one side will need to be decorated. Please remember these pumpkins will be displayed outdoors and should be decorated with durable materials and treated with some form of sealant. To secure your pumpkin, please complete the application below.

WHEN:

Applications must be submitted by Monday, September 21. Please include a \$10 material fee with your application. Your fee includes one primed and cut wooden pumpkin and reserves your spot in the installation.

Pumpkins will be available for pickup at the Acworth Community Center (4361 Cherokee Street) on September 22 from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. **Please return your decorated pumpkin to the Acworth Community Center by Monday, October 5 by 8:00 p.m.**

Pumpkins will be installed at Logan Farm Park on October 6 and be displayed through November 1. If you wish to keep your pumpkin at the end of the exhibition, you may pick it up at the Acworth Community Center November 3-November 6.

AWARDS:

Once all eligible pumpkins are in place a team of judges will review all entries to award prizes in the following categories:

1. Best Overall: The pumpkin That is most visually appealing, seasonal, and stands out above all other applicants.
2. Most Creative: The pumpkin goes above and beyond in creativity based on design and materials.
3. Spookiest Pumpkin: The pumpkin that best captures the Halloween spirit.
4. Silliest Pumpkin: The pumpkin that is the most playful and goofy.
5. Mayor's Choice: Mayor Tommy Allegood will review all entries and choose his favorite!

LIMITATIONS:

We ask that you please keep in mind that this art installation will be displayed at Logan Farm Park and on view for many children. Spooky is great, but please do no gore or blood. Think PG-rated pumpkins. Due to limited space and availability, we are limiting pumpkins to one per household/organization.
