Budget Workshop – Integrated Health Care Services

Director Guse, along with Environmental Health Director Taff, reviewed the proposed budgets for the following programs within Fund #104:

- Mental Health – capital outlay expenses of \$25,000 were identified
- Substance Use Disorder – no capital outlay expenses were identified
- Chemical Dependency/Prevention – capital outlay expense of \$5,000 was identified
- Personal Health – no capital outlay expenses were identified; a CE transfer of \$107,210 was requested for COVID expenses, if needed; and, a CE operating transfer of \$278,186 was requested
- Environmental Health – capital outlay expense of \$4,000 was identified; a CE operating transfer of \$95,000 was requested

IHCS Prevention Contract K3902, Amendment #2

Commissioner Marshall moved, Thompson seconded, to *authorize the Chairman to sign Contract K3902, Amendment #2, between Washington State Health Care Authority and Adams County Health Department for an increase of \$20,000 for a total contract award of \$235,000 for the period July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2021. Motion carried.* (Added funding to agreement for prevention services within the Othello School District boundaries; amendment restated the entire contract and replaces prior terms and conditions. The contents and attachments are the same or similar in language just rearranged and re-

numbered throughout the agreement; agency provides the same prevention services to the Othello School District boundaries.)
