Board Updates

The Board reviewed a request of Mayor Paula Bell, Town of Lind, to purchase a piece of property, owned by Adams County through the foreclosure process. The Board provided **consensus authorization for a title search to be conducted to determine if there are outstanding liens against the property.**

Commissioner Blankenship reviewed the Washington State Association of Counties (WSAC) virtual meeting topics, noting he will attempt to obtain the slide deck of the presentation on USDA loans. Additionally, Commissioner Blankenship provided updates on the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) process.

Commissioner Weise reported on interactions with the Building and Planning Department regarding the Sheriff's Evidence Building project.

Commissioner Thompson reported on his attendance at the People Against Illegal Drugs (P.A.I.D.) meeting last week.

Board Discussion/Decision Items

Human Resources – Human Resource Manager Perez reviewed the modified job description, as well as salary placement, for Position No. 902 – Administrative Assistant in the Juvenile Department. Action is anticipated on June 7, 2022.

A policy for new positions, or reclassifications of current positions, was reviewed with the Board providing input on the proposed policy. Additionally present were Payroll Deputy Bowman and Prosecutor Flyckt.

Adams County Fairgrounds

Roger Ensz, Othello Fair Board member, reviewed proposed plans to build a permanent, moveable 12X20, twelve (12) foot tall stage at the Adams

County Fairgrounds. The Board provided **consensus authorization for Chairman Weise to sign the Building Permit presented by Mr. Ensz for construction of the stage.** Additionally, the Board provided **consensus authorization for Mr. Ensz to paint the front of the Exhibit Building.** Ensz noted the Exhibit Building will be painted a barn red hue with both projects considered community service projects.

Building and Planning Department Fee Schedule

**ORDER OF BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
ADAMS COUNTY, WASHINGTON**

**IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING AN ADAMS COUNTY BUILDING PERMIT FEE
SCHEDULE AND REPEALING ALL OTHER RESOLUTIONS THAT ARE
INCONSISTENT WITH THESE PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, Adams County has the authority to establish a fee schedule for the various building permits (IBC Section 109) and land use permits (ACC 17.88.060) required within the unincorporated portions of Adams County.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following attached Fee Schedule A, labeled "Master Fee Schedule" is hereby adopted and becomes effective immediately upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other resolutions or adopted fee schedules pertaining to ACC Title's 15, 16, 17, and 18 that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution are repealed.
