The Adams County LEPC held its monthly meeting at the Adams County Fire District in Othello WA on June 16, 2022. Sandi with Adams County Emergency Management opened the meeting at 10:05 am and concluded at 11:10 am.

Welcome & Introductions:

Approval of Minutes:

Old of Continuing Business:

1. Meeting schedule, the group spoke about meeting every two months rather than monthly. Members were surveyed and one request was made for quarterly meetings many of the other members preferred every other month. The decision was made to meet every other month, with the next meeting being held in August. Following meetings will be held on the third Thursday of every even month of the year.

1. Active Shooter Planning:
 - a. Does your organization have an Active Shooter Plan?

Most of the organizations did not have a formal Active Shooter Plan, most organizations have had some Active Shooter training*.



b. Does your organization have the ability to lock down the facility?

Most of the organizations are either currently not open to the public or able to lock down their facilities.

c. Who has the authority to call a lock down?

Some of the organizations had few staff with the ability to call a lock down while other facilities had many to all staff being able to call a lock down.
