### **Presentation:**

The Adams County Sheriff's Office presented Citizens Response to an Active Shooter Presentation was given by Undersheriff Coronado.

- Spoke about being able to do the "Active Attack Event" with any organization – Currently Officer Coronado is the only instructor, but they have two other officers being trained to train right now and they should have a full training team up and running before too long. The name of Active Shooter has been changed to Active Attack Event because that is all inclusive. It is not just the gun threat any more there are machetes, bombs, and other weapon options.
- They have changed the RUN-HIDE-Fight to AVOID- DENY-DEFEND meaning avoid the threat however possible, deny the threat access to where you are hiding and defend anyway you can. There are no rules when it comes to defend except to don't stop fighting until the weapon of choice is away from the intruder
- When officers arrive on scene you are to follow their every command without question to be safe
- They encourage you to train your brain ahead of time. Walk through your area know what your options are and review that so that if an event happens in your area, you can effectively manage the fear and make smart choices for your safety.
