DETECTING THEFT

According to the Louisville Metro Police Department, there has been a recent increase in thefts from vehicles reported throughout Louisville. They recommend following these guidelines to protect your vehicles and deter thefts.



- Lock your car!
- Park in your garage if possible or in a well-lit area.
- Always do a nightly check to make sure your garage is closed.
- Do not leave valuables in your car, including wallets, purses, GPS devices, cell phones, backpacks, etc.
- Never leave your car running unattended.
- Do not hide a key in your car or attached to the outside.
- If you park outside, remove any garage door openers or key fobs from your vehicle.
- Turn on your outside lights at night. This helps officers on patrol to see if anyone is lurking around your property.

If you see suspicious activity, report it immediately. Call 911, or the Anchorage Police Department at 244-0562.

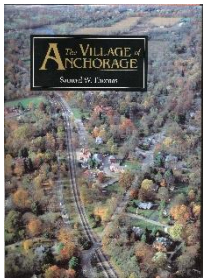
2020 Holiday Ornament
