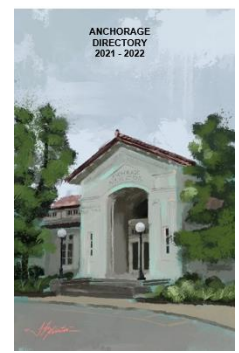
## ANCHORFEST 2021

## COMING SOON! TEN20 CRAFT BREWERY

You may have seen some construction going on in the depot building next to The Village Anchor Restaurant. Well, that is the site of TEN20's first satellite taproom scheduled to open in mid-November.

TEN20 Craft Brewery opened in Butchertown last year debuting it's 24,000 square foot brewery, taproom, and event venue. It's immediate and sustained broad popularity has allowed the brewery to expand its operations sooner than originally thought, with its first satellite tap room coming to Anchorage.

Dean Holland, Founding Chairman and 27-year Anchorage resident said, "I am delighted that we are bringing our first satellite taproom to the Anchorage community. TEN20's mission "to bring people together for good" using our really, really good beer as a social currency, fits so well with this vibrant, socially conscious community. My partners and I are thrilled with this opportunity."
