As an Anchorage resident and participant in the 2022 Canopy Tree Program, I agree to the following statements by initialing each, and signing below. I acknowledge that without this signed agreement, the Forestry Board will be unable to deliver and plant my trees.

I agree to waive any and all liability of the Forestry Board or their assigns for the planting, care, and the future maintenance of the tree/trees purchased and planted.

The Forestry Board will contact Before You Dig to locate and mark buried utilities. I agree that it is my responsibility to locate any invisible fencing, sprinkler system, or overhead lines. Failure to do so is my responsibility for repair and expense.

I understand there is no warranty on the trees.

I understand that if the flags that will be provided are not in the ground and at the location where my tree/trees should be planted when the planters come to plant, I will not receive the ordered trees. It is my responsibility to make sure the flags are not removed by service people. **NO FLAGS, NO TREES, NO REFUNDS.**
