### **City Storm Debris Dumpster Available behind Anchorage Firehouse**

After declaring a state of emergency, Mayor Neil Ramsey has taken additional steps to assist residents with the recent storm debris clean-up. A large dumpster is available behind the Anchorage firehouse next to the public works salt bin so residents may dispose of storm or yard debris, such as limbs, branches, small diameter trees, broken wooden fence slats, (not full trees or construction materials, metal fencing, household items, etc.). This is strictly for residential use – please no commercial or business contractors. The dumpster will be available until June 12. The mayor has also approved as an emergency outside tree contractors to expedite storm debris removal in the City. Public Works staff continue to work with LG&E and cable providers to restore service and open roads.

A huge thank you to the public works and police department staff for their tireless efforts in keeping residents safe, roads open, and services available. A special thank you to the Anchorage Emergency Preparedness Committee for once again contacting the most vulnerable City residents.

### **Other Debris Removal Options**

As a reminder, Republic Services is operating on a one-day delay. Yard waste pick-up will be Friday, May 31. Each bag, box or container is limited to 35 lbs. Pick-up is curbside. There is a limit of 20 paper lawn bags or boxes per residence. Please be sure there is open and full access to the yard waste for pick-up.

# TREE REMOVAL PERMITS

---

Anchorage is a highly sought-after place to live partly because of the beauty that comes from having a large tree population. Anchorage ordinances provide protection for trees and require residents to obtain a permit when removing certain trees. Trees that are three inches or more in diameter, alive or dead, whether standing or fallen must have a permit to be removed. **Trees knocked down by storms may be removed immediately, but must be reported by providing a photo with a tree notification form to City Hall within five business days.** Forms are available on the [City website](#) or at City Hall. A photo of each tree and a map with the location of each tree to be removed needs to accompany the tree removal notification form. If you have questions, call City Hall at 502.245.4654.

## Short-term Rentals are Prohibited in Anchorage

---

The zoning code for the City of Anchorage does not permit the short-term rental of any property within the City. This includes homes, rooms within a home, and unimproved land as part of a lot or open space. When any property, or a portion thereof, is rented, leased, or otherwise assigned for a period of less than 30 days, that use is an impermissible short-term rental.

Although Louisville Metro zoning code permits certain short-term rentals including those done through hosting platforms such as Airbnb and VRBO, Anchorage does not permit any form of short-term rental. Short-term rentals of property within Anchorage can be turned over to Metro Code Enforcement for investigation and citation. Any resident has the right to file a complaint with Metro.

## Golf Cart Inspection Day June 1

---

### Is Your Golf Cart Legal to Drive on Anchorage Roads?

Golf carts must be inspected by the Jefferson County Sheriff and have an Anchorage road use permit sticker to be driven on Anchorage Roads. The Jefferson County Sheriff will be at the Anchorage Police Station on Saturday, June 1 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. to conduct inspections.
