They stated she does not believe semi-trucks need to come down their street, especially with school starting back. They stated it is very dangerous. They believes they should go down Prairie Lane and tear up one road instead of several interior streets. They brought some items that they picked up and said they were from semi trucks trash. Mr. Robertson gave an example of a semi truck from Apache that was going 20 miles out of town but went down their street.

Ms. Joyce stated she agreed to the speed sign on her yard thinking the speed would stay at 25mph. She also stated her yard has piles of dirt from all the subdivision. She said the ordinance needs to have more teeth in it and they need to plan future subdivisions better in the future.
