No Council action will be taken.</p> <p>Two citizens requested to speak regarding Item X, Tony Lewis, and Emily Robertson.</p> <p>Ms. Robertson stated she moved to 12th street 7 years ago. It was a quiet dead-end street. It has steadily gotten worse, with last year being very bad. She asked for stop signs at the end of the street, and those were installed. Has constantly had issues with dirt and tumbleweeds. She stated she does not believe semi-trucks need to come down their street, especially with school starting back. She stated it is very dangerous. On the previous Tuesday, she witnessed concrete trucks coming down 12th, to NW Mustang to NW 13th instead of using the truck route. She believes they should go down Prairie Lane and tear up one road instead of several.</p> <p>Mr. Lewis also lives on NW 12th street. He believes the intent of the ordinance passed in 2013 was to divert trucks out of the city and this ordinance would give police "zero teeth" to enforce truck traffic. Isn't concerned about new growth and development but need to guide trucks on best way to get trucks around town.</p>
