

**ORDINANCE NO. 1228**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF INOPERABLE VEHICLES FROM THE STREETS, ALLEYWAYS AND PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAYS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANDREWS, TEXAS IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS THEREOF AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDREWS:

SECTION 1. The parking of inoperable vehicles on the streets, alleyways, and/or public right-of-ways within the city limits of the City of Andrews, Texas is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2. Definition of "inoperable vehicle"- An "inoperable vehicle" shall be any vehicle not displaying a current license and safety inspection sticker when required by law for operation upon public streets.


SECTION 3. Penalty - Upon violation, the Police shall place a written notice on the vehicle allowing the owner SEVENTY TWO HOURS (72 hours) in which to comply with the licensing and inspection requirement or to remove the vehicle from the street, alleyway, or public right-of-way. If said vehicle is not brought into compliance or removed within the allotted period of time, the vehicle will be towed, impounded and disposed of in compliance with applicable State Law. The owner or lienholder of an impounded vehicle shall have the right to redeem and reclaim said vehicle by paying all towing fees, impoundment fees and costs of impoundment.

SECTION 4. Enforcement - Enforcement of the provisions of this ordinance shall be by the City Of Andrews Police Department.


SECTION 5. Effective Date - This ordinance shall be effective on and after August 23, 1998.
