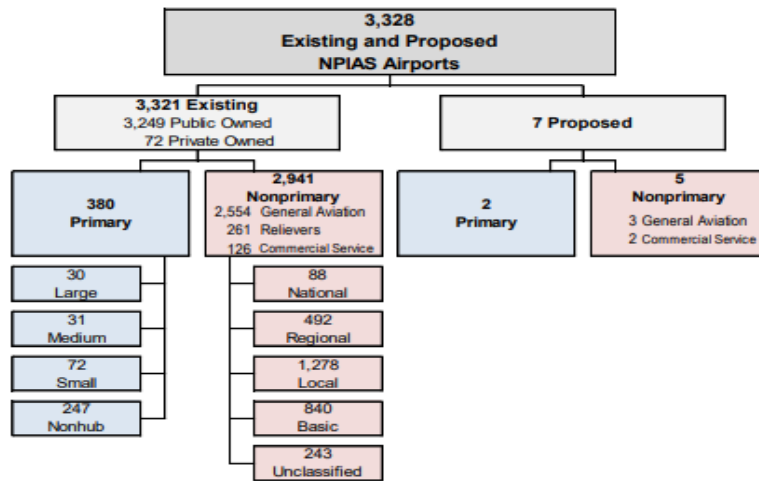

The hangars were completed the summer/fall of 2022.

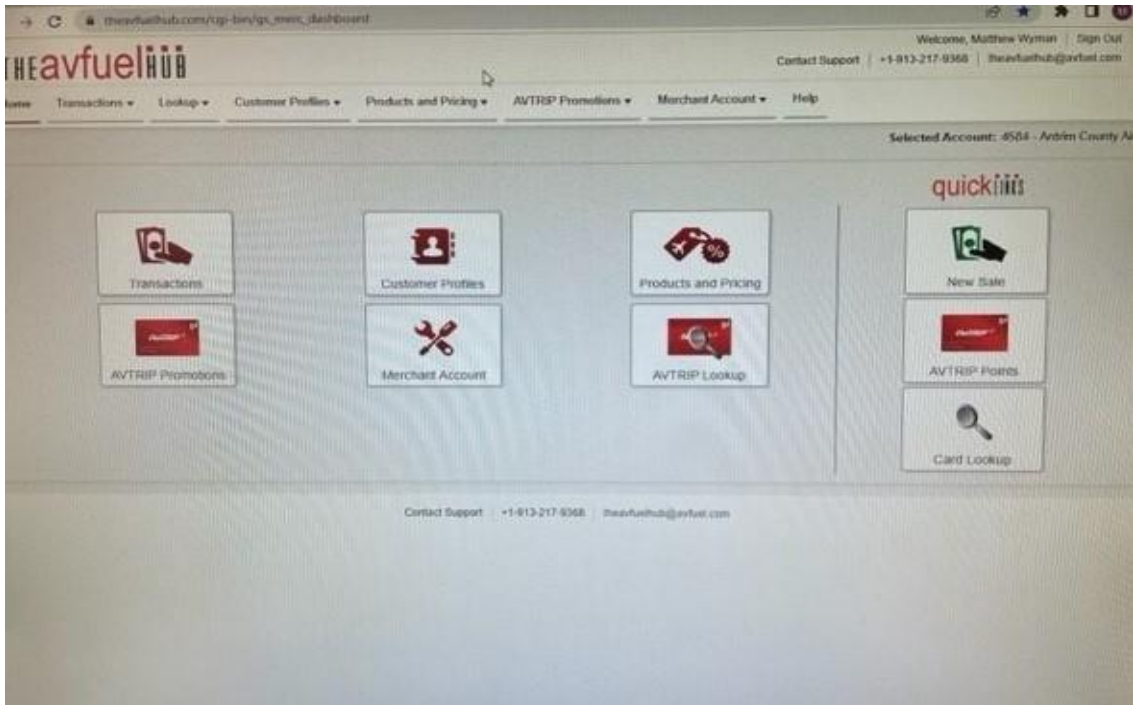


Although the addition of 2 new hangars were good additions to ACB, we now find ourselves with no more space for more hangar development. This is why the programming of a new taxiway for the Fall of 2023 is so vitally important. The new taxiway will give us the capacity attract new tenants and grow as an airport community. An additional 3-5 hangars will boost our hangar revenue an additional \$4,600 to \$7,700 annually, not to mention additional revenue from fuel sales.

## Moving Forward

As we look into the future of aviation and our community, there are exciting times ahead. The strategic planning of the former Airport Director, Airport Consultant and Board leadership, ACB is well positioned to play an important role in the growth of our community and the ever-changing aviation industry.

To help us in this mission, we've added the AvFuel HUB system. The HUB will allow us to accurately track revenue streams operations, fuel sales and

In addition, we've enrolled into the online AvFuel training program. The program will equip our team with current best practices in fuel quality assurance, ramp safety, customer service, and sales/leadership.
