### Pre-Registering for COVID-19 Vaccination

ANTRIM COUNTY, Mich. – Antrim County Emergency Management has been working with the Health Department of Northwest Michigan over the last few weeks to get individuals in current priority groups vaccinated. The Health Department is now pre-registering individuals and employers falling under priority group 1B, which includes police, fire department personnel, school personnel, and individuals age 65 and older. Once pre-registered at <http://nwhealth.org/covid19immform> on nwhealth.org, the Health Department will reach out via email with a link to schedule appointment times as clinics are scheduled.

For those unable to access the internet, the Health Department of Northwest Michigan is encouraging individuals 65 and older to call the Area Agency on Aging at **231-715-5557** with questions. Antrim County residents 65 and older are encouraged to contact the *Antrim County Commission on Aging* at **231-533-8703** for assistance pre-registering. Antrim County veterans over the age of 65 unable to access the website can call the *Antrim County Veteran Affairs* at **231-533-8499** for assistance.

At this time, we are asking that only those who qualify under group 1B to utilize these numbers due to limited resources of the Health Department and other agencies.
