#### **Project description**

160 of these radios would be used to outfit all firefighters serving Antrim County. The other 20 would serve as the emergency cache of radios for use as needed by first responders. As the use of 800 MHz radios has grown exponentially over the past 5 years, the need for radios to utilize by CERT, Auxiliary Officers and staff has become more apparent. As an example, the majority of firefighters do not have portable 800's. During the EF3 Tornado in Gaylord, their biggest request from Antrim County was for light towers. Many of our departments used pick-ups to transport the towers. Once on scene, they were unable to communicate as all responders were on 800 radios. The CERT and RACES Teams also use 800's for events such as Whitepine Stampede and Paddle Antrim. We currently borrow radios form Charlevoix County and MSP. This will allow them to communicate with all first responders during these large events.

#### Why is this project needed?

Allowing all first responders and staff to communicate during events, emergencies and disasters is paramount for interoperable communications.

Are any future costs (such as annual fees) associated with this project? If so, please estimate. Will there be any savings if the project is approved?

Future costs may include necessary programming and maintenance. If the County is to retain ownership of the radios and maintain the supply in perpetuity, the County would be responsible for replacement at end of life.
