

ANTRIM COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS

The meeting of the Antrim County Board of Canvassers met Monday, November 17, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. in the County Clerk's office in the Antrim County Building.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 1:45 p.m.

The County Clerk presented the re-districting map representing Commissioner District #7 containing Chestonia Township, Star Township and Mancelona Township. She explained the district lines that were changed in 2011 after the 2010 Census, and that the Qualified Voters File (QVF) had placed one voter in the incorrect district, his family members were corrected before voting November 4, 2014 General Election. Three voters did vote in District #7 and should have voted in District #9. These voters have voted this way since 2008 and 2010. The three voters have not reported that they were given the incorrect ballot and may not be aware. The difference in votes was fourteen (14) not enough to change the outcome. The Bureau of Elections - QVF Street indexing department have made these corrects in the QVF Street indexing system.

Dawn LaVanway candidate for the County Commissioner District #7 stated that she will be filing a recount for County Commissioner District #7 – Echo Township and Jordan Township. She was also satisfied with the detail of the map and voter location.

The Board proceeded to canvass the returns for the 2014 General Election containing the results of Banks Township, Chestonia Township, Echo Township, Jordan Township, and Warner Township.

The Board called Kearney Township Clerk in to go over ballot totals and remarks, it was agreed that she would return Thursday, November 20, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. to verify and complete Kearney Township.

The meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
