BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
3:30 P.M.-VIA ZOOM

Mayor Slinker called the special meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. on April 20, 2023 via zoom.

Mayor Slinker called the roll:

Ward One: Nathan Volkart-absent, Loren Plank-here  
Ward Two: Melissa Old-here, Stephanie Bell-here  
Ward Three: Rick Lewis-here, David Wilson -here

Staff Present: Darla Sapp, City Clerk and Kyle Michel, City Administrator

Mayor Slinker presented the agenda for approval. Alderman Plank made motion and seconded by Alderman Wilson to approve the agenda for April 20, 2023. Mayor Slinker called for the vote. Motion carried.

Mayor Slinker called for staff report regarding the yard waste service agreement for FY24. Kyle Michel, City Administrator reported stated he put out a request for bids for curbside yard waste collection. He stated he received two proposals from Salter Lawn Service one for one day a week and one for two days a week. He stated Alderman Lewis contacted Salters if they would be interested in this service. He stated the one-day a week would be on Tuesday and the two day would be Tuesday and Thursday. He stated he is proposing the two days a week since we did have 7 days a week drop off site. He stated the one-day a week would be \$2,300.00 a month and two days would be \$2,500.00. He stated he has talked with Stacy Salter and the resident would need to call them by 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to be placed on the list for curbside pick-up. He stated the yard debris is the same as far as leaves, twigs, straw, pine needles, grass clippings, shrubby trimmings, branches and tree trimmings, small twigs must be bagged or be tied together. He stated if there is a large storm and damage from high winds, major weather or tornados there would be an additional hourly charge per person for pick up. He shared the agreement with the Board. He asked if the Board had any questions. Alderwoman Old asked if the materials to be picked up are comparable to what we did have at Crazy Dicks. Kyle Michel, stated it is comparable service and it is for residential produced lawn care. He stated the resident would need to call a head to schedule the pickup. He stated Stacy Salter stated they could start next week and prorata the fee. He stated this is a one-year contract with the option to extended for an additional three years, upon mutual agreement of both parties.

Mayor Slinker questioned if root balls would be accepted. Kyle Michel, stated they would not be.

Alderman Lewis asked if the days of the week could be flexible. Kyle Michel stated we should have set times and days.

Alderman Plank made motion and seconded by Alderman Lewis to approve the resolution and enter into agreement with Salter Lawn Care for two days a week curbside yard disposal services as outlined in the agreement. Mayor Slinker called for the vote. Alderman Plank-aye, Alderwoman Old-aye, Alderwoman Bell-aye, Alderman Wilson-aye, Alderman Lewis-aye, Alderman Volkart-absent. Motion carried.

Alderman Wilson made motion and seconded by Alderman Plank to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.
