AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1251, DESIGNATING ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS IN CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ASHLAND, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 20, Article VI: One-Way Streets and Alleys:

The Board of Aldermen hereby repeals the ordinance designating the following streets and alleys to be one-way:

- 1) Redbud Lane from two lane to one way, westbound, from Henry Clay Blvd. to Main Street
- 2) Johnson Avenue from two lane to one way, eastbound, from Main Street to Henry Clay Blvd.

Section 2. The City Traffic Engineer shall have signs removed.
