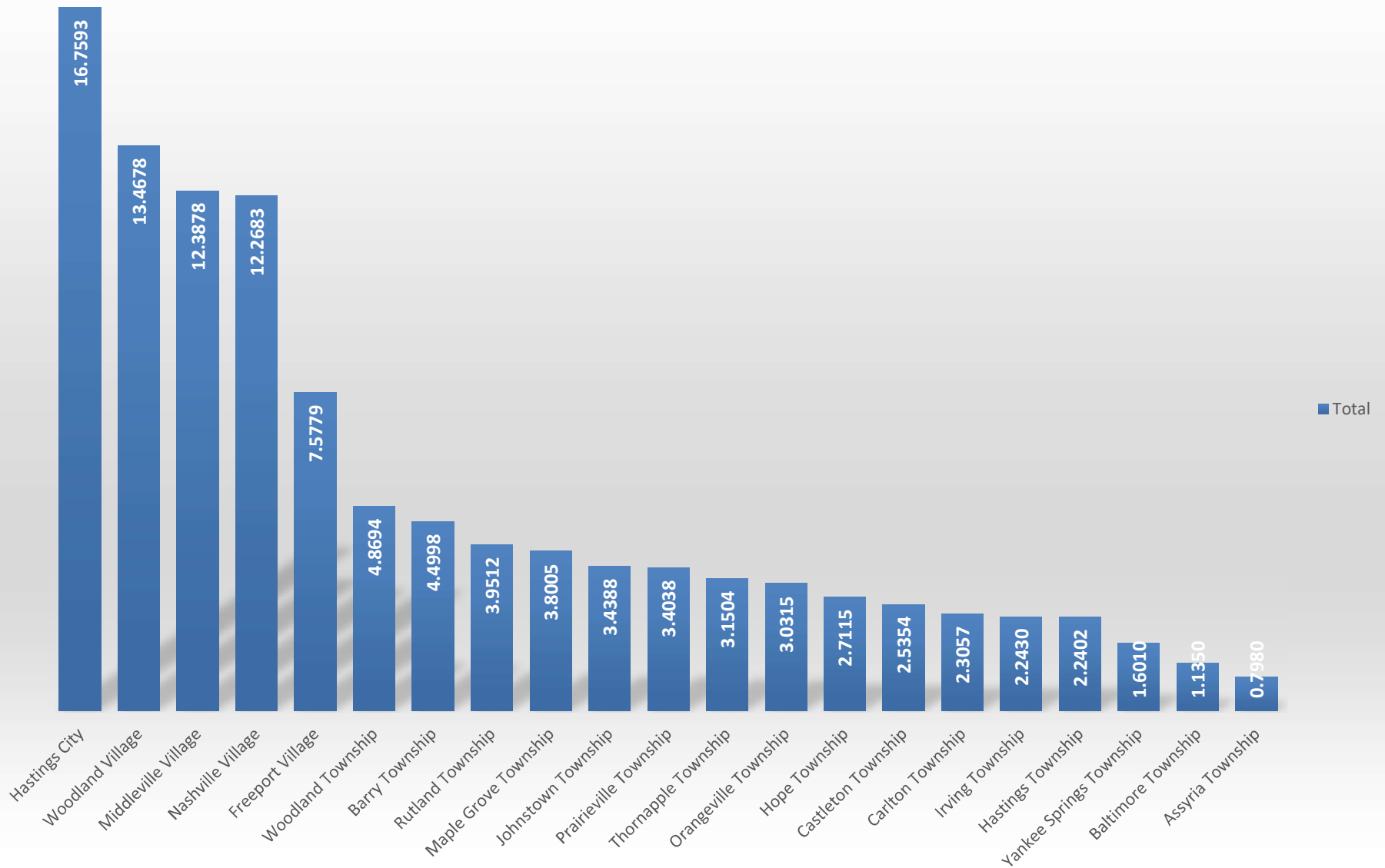

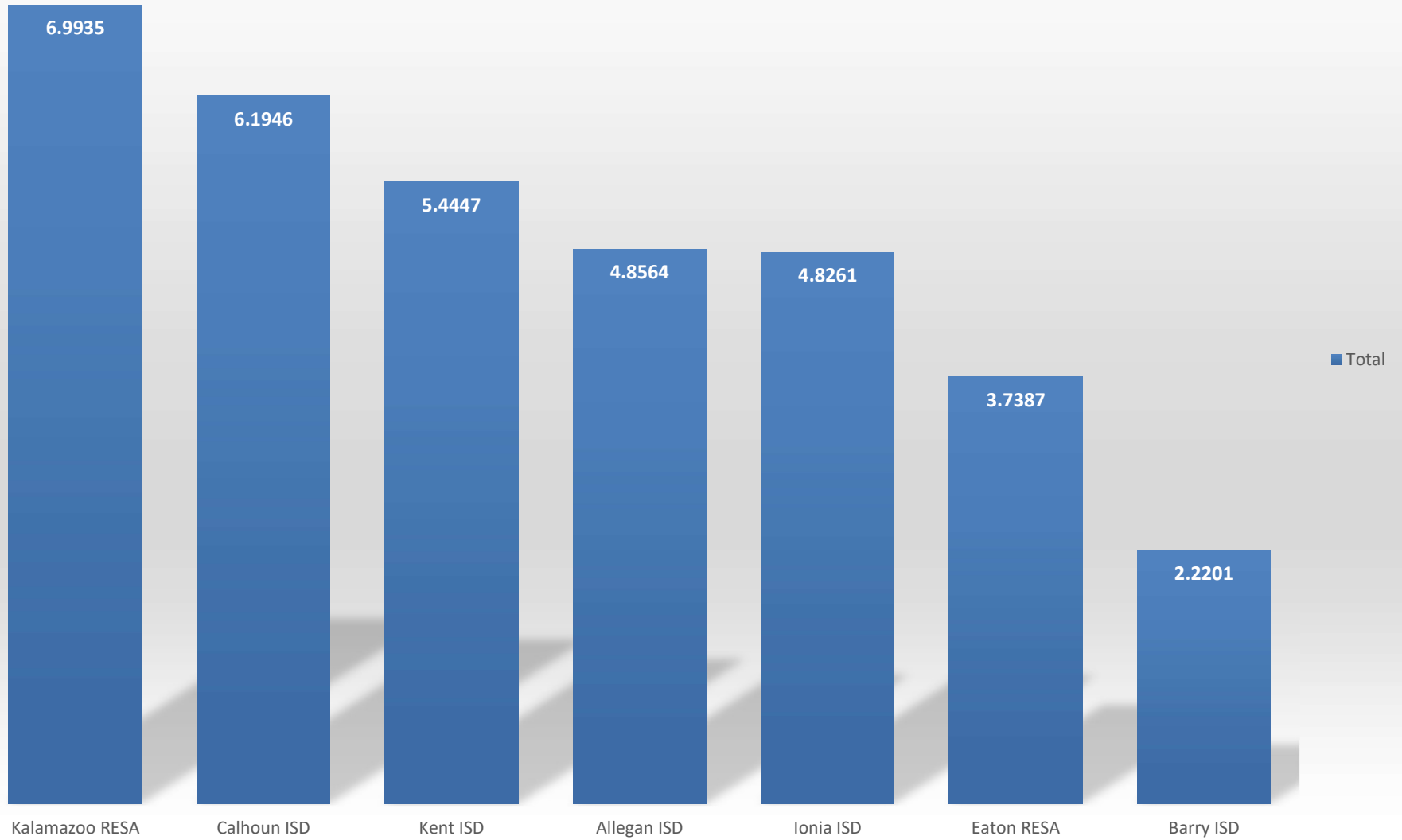

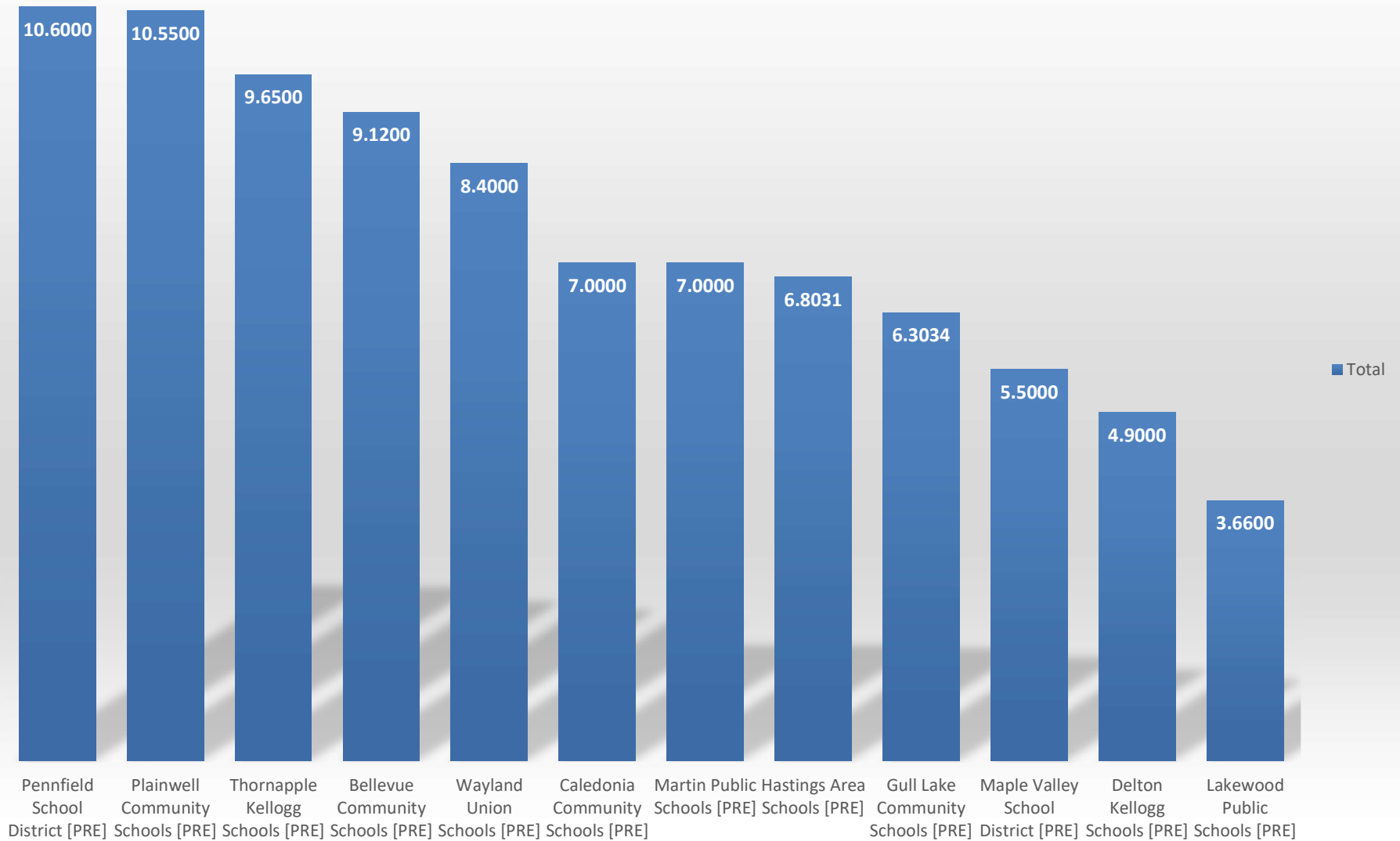
Total Millage by Government Unit



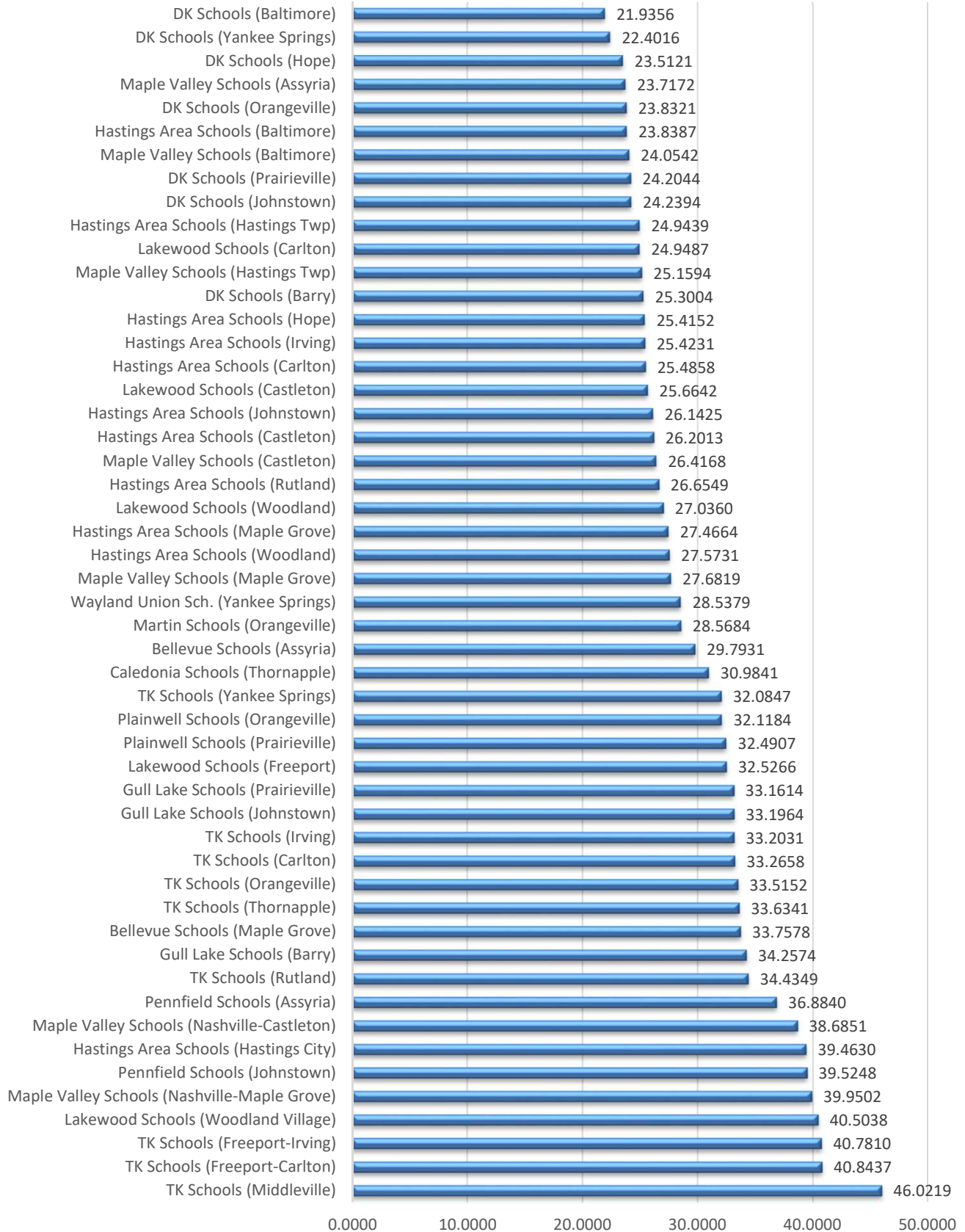
Total by ISD Millage

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DESCRIPTION OF ACTION:

On October 10, 2023, a special (emergency) meeting of the local Community Corrections Advisory Board (CCAB) was convened to assess the state's grant proposal for the fiscal year 2024. During the meeting, the CCAB received information about the total grant award, the alterations made to programs by the state, and the ensuing challenges faced by the local Office of Community Corrections.

Following an extensive and deliberative discussion, the CCAB has chosen to decline the proposal presented by the Michigan Department of Corrections, Office of Community Corrections for Fiscal Year 2024. Consequently, the decision now rests with the Barry County Board of Commissioners, who will determine whether to approve or reject the grant proposal.

ANY OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The Michigan Office of Community Corrections (MOCC) is established as a distinct entity within the Michigan Department of Corrections (MDOC), with operational autonomy independent of the Director of the Department of Corrections. Its inception, pursuant to Michigan Public Act 511, was primarily aimed at enhancing the state's

effectiveness in reducing prison commitments by employing evidence-based community corrections programs. This strategic initiative specifically targeted individuals under felony probation with MDOC.

Annually, the local Office of Community Corrections prepares and submits grant applications that delineate programs, services, and operating budgets, accompanied by projected enrollment figures for each program. The MDOC's supervisory approach has transitioned from an enforcement model to a coaching model.

Unfortunately, the MOCC's prerequisites do not align with MDOC's new policy, potentially leading to a deficit in program enrollments. This misalignment subsequently affects our capacity to operate efficiently and could have repercussions on the reimbursement received from the MOCC grant. Consequently, this situation may necessitate Barry County to allocate additional funds to sustain this program.

IV. STATE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ASSESSMENT

A. CCAB Comprehensive Corrections Plan – Impact Analysis and Recommendations

Barry County's proposed FY 2024 Comprehensive Corrections Plan is a continuation plan that targets sentenced felons through the use of multiple cognitive group programs, a relapse prevention group, and substance abuse testing for felony treatment courts. The County also proposes to target prison diversion cases, specifically those charged with a felony but pled down to a misdemeanor as part of a plea agreement with participation in an approved treatment court; however, the County failed to provide any supportive data as directed in the funding application. This is addressed in the Contractual Conditions Section. The County also projects a decrease in overall total program enrollments by 19.2% for FY 2024 and an increase in length of stay for at least one program.

OMNI felony dispositional data indicates that Barry County's PCRs are relatively comparable to or lower than the Statewide rates in most categories. For FY 2022, the County's Overall PCR was 21.6%, just 3.2 percentage points higher than the Statewide PCR. It's Group 2 Straddle Cell PCR was less than half that of the State at just 9.1% (Statewide: 20.3%). The County's OUIL-3rd PCR was 9.1%, with only 1 prison disposition out of 11 OUIL-3rd dispositions. It is noted that the County continues to report concerns with the accuracy of their OMNI felony dispositional data.

It is recommended that the Barry County FY 2024 Comprehensive Corrections plan be conditionally supported with modification.

B. Contractual Conditions

1. FY 2024 recommended CPS award: **\$154,210**. The total administration line item cannot exceed 30% of the total award. The County must submit a revised budget document at the time of the submission of the signed contract indicating the funding allocation per line item for the following programs: C01 Cog Program (both male and female groups), C01 Seeking Safety, G18 Relapse Prevention, and G17 Drug Testing Program. If these changes impact your projected new enrollments, the County must submit revised enrollment information to your assigned Community Corrections Specialist for review and approval.
2. If the County wants to target/enroll prison diversion offenders as identified in all program descriptions, then it must revise Part One to include the following:
 - Section 2-A, #3b: Per the instructions in this section, the County must provide a supportive data analysis that includes the prison diversion population of offenders charged with a felony but pled down to a misdemeanor as part of a plea agreement with participation in an approved treatment court.
3. The C01 Cog Program – Both Male and Female Group program descriptions must be revised to include the following:
 - Approved Target Population is: Sentenced Felons.
 - Approved Eligibility Criteria are: Sentenced felony offenders who score moderate to high in at least one of the following COMPAS Criminogenic Needs Scales: Substance Abuse, Cognitive Behavioral, Criminal Personality, Social Environment, Family Criminality, Social Isolation, Criminal Opportunity, or Criminal Association; -OR- Felony probation violators regardless of COMPAS score.

- The County must remove the language that indicates the use of individual sessions. Per the Contract, all groups must have 3 or more OCC enrolled offenders attending the session for the session to qualify as a group. For any and all exceptions, the County must follow the MOCC override/waiver procedure process.
4. The C01 Seeking Safety Group program description must be revised to include the following:
 - Approved Target Population is: Sentenced Felons.
 - #2(e)iv – The County must review the identified maximum number of participants per group and revise if inaccurate.
 - The County must remove the language that indicates the use of individual sessions. Per the Contract, all groups must have 3 or more OCC enrolled offenders attending the session for the session to qualify as a group. For any and all exceptions, the County must follow the MOCC override/waiver procedure process.
 5. The G18 Relapse Prevention Group program descriptions must also be revised to include the following:
 - Approved Target Population is: Sentenced Felons.
 - Approved eligibility criteria are: For referral: Sentenced male felony offenders who score moderate to high in at least one of the following COMPAS Criminogenic Needs Scales: Substance Abuse or Cognitive Behavioral; - OR- Male felony probation violator, regardless of COMPAS score, with a documented need for the program. All enrollees must be sentenced felons and have a current substance abuse assessment confirming need for the program.
 6. The G17 Drug Testing Program service description must be revised to include the following:
 - Approved Target Population and Eligibility Criteria are: Sentenced felony offenders currently participating in an eligible felony treatment court.
 7. The Budget Cost Description Section must be revised to include the following:
 - PA 511 funds shall not be used to locally track OMNI felony dispositional data.
 - PA 511 funds are not pre-approved for any video communications programs and must be removed. The County may submit a Budget Adjustment Request (BAR) if any group program switches to a virtual platform.
 - Individual sessions for any and all group programming are not pre-approved. For any and all exceptions, the County must follow the MOCC override/waiver procedure process.
 8. All revisions must be submitted to the assigned Community Corrections Specialist no later than October 31, 2023.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTION: Each year, prior to the January 1st renewal date for health insurance, the Barry County Healthcare Cost Containment Committee meets to review health insurance plans and associated employer/employee contributions for the coming year, and makes a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners regarding the health plan choices they desire for County employees. The Healthcare Cost Containment Committee met in September to review 2024 proposed plans and rates for plans offered in the West Michigan Pool. There are many plans available in the West Michigan Pool. The 2024 proposed health plans are BCBS plans that most closely match the current 2023 plans. There are no Blue Care Network HMO plans offered in the Pool, so the replacement plans for the current four HMO plans will have a richer PPO plan design. Even with the plan design differences, in most cases, employees will see a reduction in their contribution to the plan premium, and for plans with a premium below the employer contribution cap, they will see an increase in the employer contribution to their Health Savings Account. This is shown on the attached Employee Contribution Comparison 2023-2024. Employee contributions for 2024 are also impacted by the increased amount of the employer contribution in 2024. The employer contribution for health insurance will increase by 4.1% as allowed per MCL 15.563, resulting in the following employer contributions: Single coverage = \$7,702.85, (annual increase of \$303.38); Two-person coverage = \$16,109.06 (annual increase of \$634.46); Family coverage = \$21,007.83 (annual increase of \$827.40).
