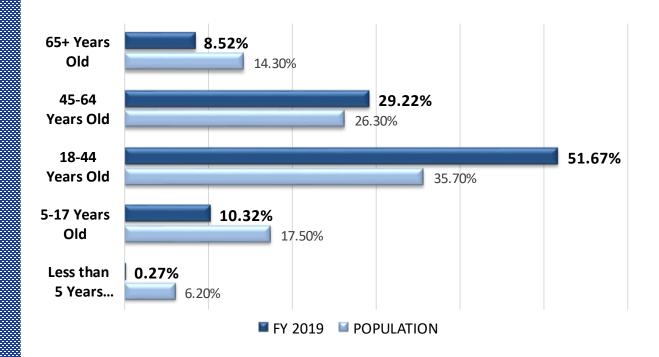

Client Age



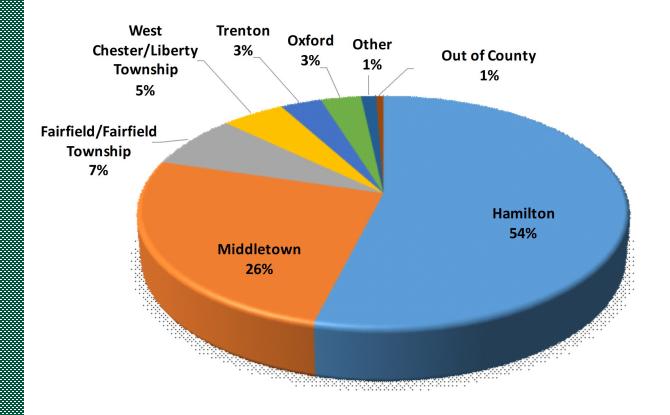

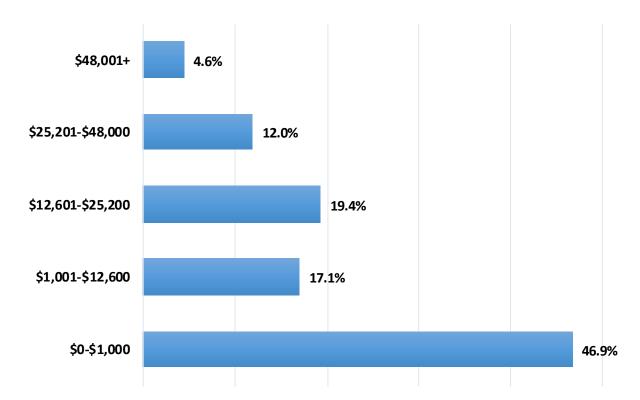

Cases by City of Residence within Butler County







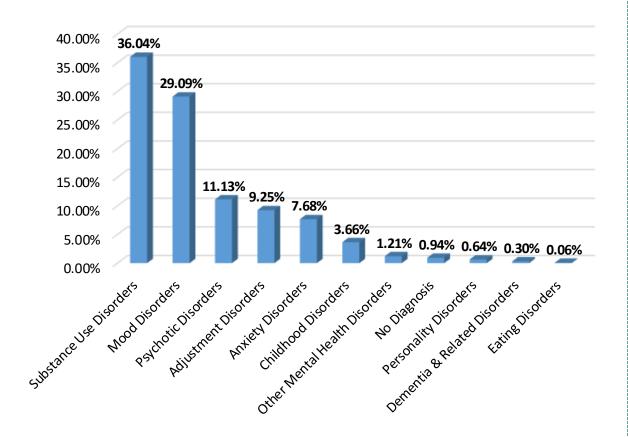

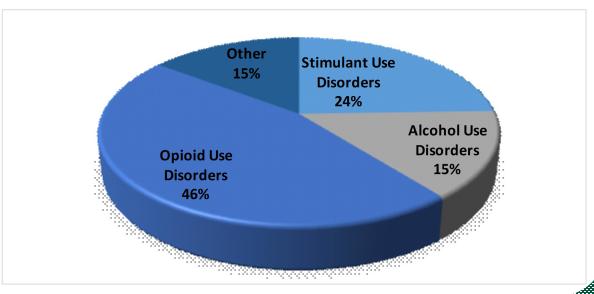

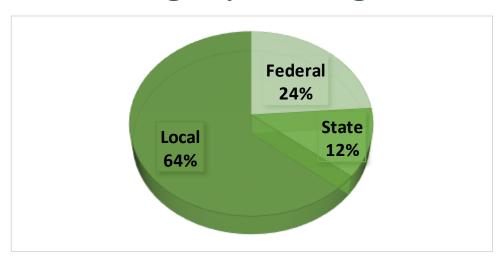

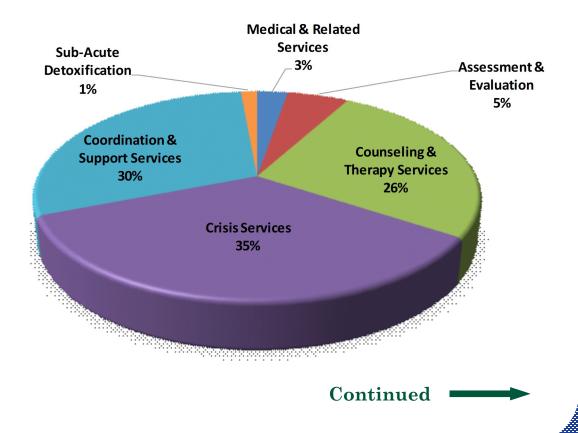
